



FR. JAMES HEYD NEWEST FULL-TIME PRIEST-ASSOCIATE OF PRIESTS FOR LIFE

On July 15 of this year, Fr. James Heyd, a priest of the Archdiocese of Chicago, began working full-time for Priests for Life. Given permission to do so by Cardinal Francis George, Archbishop of Chicago, Fr. Heyd becomes the seventh priest currently serving in this capacity (along with Fr. Frank Pavone, Fr. Peter West, Fr. Denis Wilde, OSA, Fr. Walter Quinn, OSA, Fr. Giacomo Capoverdi, and Fr. Mark Clarke, CMF).

Fr. Heyd is no stranger to Priests for Life. In fact, he served as Associate Director of the organization when Fr. Frank Pavone first became National Director in 1993. Ordained by Cardinal Joseph Bernardin, Fr. Heyd assisted the initial development of Priests for Life after being contacted by Fr. Lee Kaylor, the original founder. For years, Fr. Heyd has traveled and spoken on behalf of Priests for Life, and has visited numerous parishes to share with his brother priests the resources that Priests for Life has to offer for their preaching and parish and school activities. Fr. Heyd has served as a liaison between Priests for Life and many groups within the Church.

ELECTIONS 2006

We are only a year away from critically important elections for the United States Senate, and other offices, that impact the abortion battle. Pro-abortion forces have lost more and more elections in the last several cycles. Next year will be no different, provided we all do our part.

All issues that impact human life are critically important. But that is not to say they are all equal. Pope John Paul II wrote the following in his 1988 apostolic exhortation, *The Vocation and the Mission of the Lay Faithful in the Church and in the World (Christifideles Laici)*: "The common outcry, which is justly made on behalf of human rights - for example, the right to health, to home, to work, to family, to culture -- is false and illusory if the right to life, the most basic

and fundamental right and the condition of all other personal rights, is not defended with maximum determination" (n. 38).

Many in the Church ignore these words and continue to claim that the linkage of all the issues means the *equality* of all the issues. But linkage is not equality; it is *linkage*. The right to education depends upon the right to life. If you take the right to education away, the person is still alive. If you take the right to life away, both are gone: the person is no longer alive, and can no longer be educated. The same is true of rights to health care, housing, voting, employment, wages, a clean environment -- and, in fact, everything else. Life itself is the foundation.

No public official who fails to protect the right to life belongs in public office. This is a message we will echo and re-echo throughout the coming year, and we urge you to do the same.

BULLETIN INSERT IN SPANISH Dolor No Nacido

El 6 de abril de 2004 el Dr. Kanwaljeet Anand ofreció el siguiente testimonio en una Corte de Distrito de Estados Unidos (U.S. District Court – District of Nebraska) ante el Juez Richard G. Kopf en el caso Leroy Carhart M.D. et. al. v. Ashcroft "Pregunta: Entonces doctor, ¿tiene una opinión con respecto al dolor que el aborto de parto parcial causaría al feto?"

Respuesta: Si el feto ha pasado las 20 semanas de gestación, asumiría que se causa dolor al feto. Y creo que el dolor causado al feto sería severo y agudísimo.

P: ¿Que significa severo y agudísimo?

R: Mire, el umbral de dolor es muy bajo. El feto es probablemente muy sensible al dolor durante las 20 a 30 semanas de gestación. Luego los procedimientos asociados con el aborto de parto parcial que acabo de describir causarían probablemente dolor severo, desde el mismísimo momento en que el feto está siendo manipulado y tratado hasta que se hace la incisión y se succionan el cerebro y los contenidos intracraneanos."

In his new position as a Priest Associate, Fr. Heyd will continue speaking, traveling, and networking. He sees another important dimension of this work as well: "It is my firm belief that the pro-life movement fosters solid vocations to the priesthood and religious life, and strengthens the life and belief of the church."

Further commenting on his new role, Fr. Heyd stated, "It is a privilege to be a part of Priests for Life and be able to stand up for the voiceless preborn threatened by abortion. Father Frank Pavone has done a stellar job with this work and deserves the support of the entire church. This is not just the work of a few priests but of all of us who call ourselves Christian."

DO THE PHOTOS WORK?

Some people wonder whether graphic images of aborted babies convert anyone. Read the following email for yourself and see more of them at www.priestsforlife.org/images. We get these emails all the time.

"Hello, I am a sixteen-year-old female and I just finished looking at the pictures on your site and reading what actually happens during an abortion. Up until five minutes ago, I was extremely pro-choice. I thought things like, "let women make their own decisions about their own bodies" and things along those lines. Because of your site, I realize that abortion is not a choice about a woman's body...it is the LIFE of a BABY. Never before did I realize how truly horrible and careless abortion really is. Maybe it's because I'd never seen the pictures, or read the actual descriptions of abortion. Maybe I was too afraid to know the truth. I really don't know. But within 3 minutes of viewing your website, my face was covered in tears. Those pictures just really hurt to look at. To see an innocent child...dead before it was even born. It hurts me to know that people find this acceptable. Killing your baby just because you don't want it is beyond irresponsible. How could someone murder an innocent little baby? I thank you so, so much for your wonderful website. I cannot express how grateful I am that you have shown me the truth about abortion. God bless you. Thank you once again."

PRO-LIFE "THIRD ORDER"
