How to Get People to the Polls

In these final weeks before Election Day (November 6), it's all about actually getting voters to the polls. We therefore urge you to implement the following simple steps:

a) **Utilize early voting.** Many states allow you to vote **before Election Day**. Take advantage of this option yourself, and encourage others to do so. See www.priestsforlife.org/states for info.

b) **Remind your contacts.** Whether by phone, email, Facebook or Twitter, remind your contacts to get to the polls as early as possible. Do this as soon as early voting begins, and do it from morning to night on Election Day.

c) **Remember the homebound.** Assist those you know who cannot get to the polling places to obtain and fill out their absentee ballots. This also goes for those who will be traveling out of town.

d) **Organize transportation.** Especially on Election Day, take some time off from work and volunteer to drive people to the polls who may not have a way to get there. Transportation could be organized through Churches, other community groups, or just by you and a group of friends.

e) **Preach up a storm.** If you are a priest, pastor, or deacon, preach vigorously and frequently about the responsibility to vote, and remind your congregation to do so!
