Who are We and What Do We Do?

Priests for Life and Gospel of Life Ministries Brothers and Sisters,

Priests for Life has come to signify two distinct but related movements within the wider pro-life movement.

On one level, as described below, Priests for Life refers to a very specific effort to galvanize the clergy to preach, teach, and mobilize their people more effectively in the effort to end abortion and euthanasia.

On another level, Priests for Life represents a *family* of ministries that reach and enrich every aspect of the pro-life movement, for clergy and laity alike, in a wide variety of activities. This has come to pass precisely because *priests are not ordained for themselves, but for the people.* So in activating clergy, we are activating all the segments of the Church, the pro-life movement, and the wider society in the defense of life.

We refer to this wider family of ministries as Gospel of Life Ministries, to indicate that what unites them all is the Gospel of Life, the good news that life is victorious over death!

So whether you are clergy or laity, young or old, active or inactive, and whatever your religious or ethnic background, you're in the right place if you want to do something to restore protection to the most vulnerable members of the human family!

16,433 Children in One Grave

I had a quick visit to the West Coast on September 14 that included praying at a gravesite that contains the bodies of 16,433 children killed by abortion.

The prayer service was part of the *National Day of Remembrance*, a project organized by Priests for Life, Pro-life Action League and Citizens for a Pro-life Society. On this day, simultaneous memorial services are held at the graves of aborted babies around the nation.

The gravesite at which I prayed, located in the Odd Fellows Cemetery in East Los Angeles, is the largest of the mass graves of children killed by abortion.

That's when workers discovered what was in it -- the bodies of aborted babies, totaling 16,433. The bodies were taken into the custody of Los Angeles County.

This made news and touched off a firestorm about what should be done with the babies. Pro-life people and public officials got together to call from the release of the bodies for proper burial. Meanwhile, pro-abortion groups, including the ACLU, went to court to block any religious service, or even burial, for these babies. They claimed that the 'separation of church and state' prohibited the state from facilitating a religious service.

The court agreed. However, the pro-abortion groups wanted...

Priests for Life (direct ministry to priests)

We therefore teach both clergy and laity the spirituality of being a Missionary of the Gospel of Life, and how that spirituality shapes pro-life strategy and tactics. The Role of Priests for Life in the March for Life and Walk for Life

Join us in Washington, D.C. January 21-22 and San Francisco on January 24!

From its inception, Priests for Life has always had a major presence at the March for Life. As the years went on, and our relationship with March for Life Founder Nellie Gray grew, we were able to help more and more in various aspects of the March and other events surrounding it.

The Priests for Life Youth Outreach Department, called Stand True and led by Bryan Kemper, is entrusted with the organization and execution of the official youth rally, to be held this year on Tuesday, January 21 from 2 to 5 p.m. in the Grand Ballroom of the D.C. Renaissance Hotel.

Then, the next morning, Priests for Life plays a major role in coordinating the annual *National Memorial for the Preborn and their Mothers and Fathers*. Now in its 21st year, this prayer service starts off the day of the March for Life on Thursday, January 22, 2015, from 8:30 to 10:30 a.m., at Constitution Hall, 1776 D St., NW (18th and D St), Washington, D.C. We will start with Mass, for those who wish, at 7:30 a.m. (Doors open at 7). The prayer service is interdenominational, and is marked by the presence of dozens of clergy from every major denomination. Fr. Frank Pavone will once again give a rousing homily! Admission is free, no tickets are required, and large groups are welcome.

Then, as part of the March for Life Rally, the crowd always

hears from at least one woman who has had an abortion and now regrets it. This is arranged through our Silent No More Awareness Campaign (SilentNoMore.com), a joint project of Priests for Life and Anglicans for Life. Moreover, women and men alike who have lost children to abortion and regret it walk in the front section of the March holding their signs saying, "I Regret My Abortion" and "I Regret Lost Fatherhood." Then, when the March arrives at the Supreme Court, these men and women begin sharing their testimonies publicly in front of the steps of the court, and the marchers stop for a while to listen to and learn from them, and to pray with them. ... more, namely, *to not allow a burial at all.* They wanted the bodies cremated and thrown away as medical waste. And forgotten. With this, however, the court did not agree. Even the Supreme Court was petitioned in the matter, and in the end, after a three-year battle, the babies were buried on October 6, 1985. Even President Ronald Reagan got involved, and wrote a eulogy that was read at the service, calling for an end to abortion.

For many years, this mass grave had no marker or headstone, just as the children have no names. But now there is a stone, and we are going to name the babies. Supporters of abortion do not want people to see mass graves in our midst. It's too disturbing a reminder of the humanity of the victims of abortion. When people forget, the abortion supporters win; when people remember, we win. That is why we need to keep telling the stories of these graves, and visiting them. And that is why we continue to demand that the bodies of the babies killed by abortionist Kermit Gosnell in Philadelphia be released so that we can bury them.

Ironically, the 16,433 aborted children in Los Angeles could not be buried at the nearby Catholic cemetery; but who is buried there? The late-term abortionist James McMahon.

God help us.


