## **God's Victory Over Death**

We just finished a retreat for the Ann Arbor/ Detroit area. The retreat went well. It is really hard to express the Godly encounter that takes place at these retreats. The words I have for this one is an awareness of the victory of the Gospel over death. Right before your eyes you see the transformation of women and men who have experienced death. They experienced the death of their children and their own spiritual and emotional death. While listening to their stories throughout the weekend you become very aware of the hand of God drawing them back into relation with Him and with their children. We cried buckets of tears. I can't tell anymore if they are tears of sadness or joy, it all gets mixed up. Yes, you witness an immense emotional pain but also an overpowering joy of seeing God's hand drawing these women and men back to Himself. I'm trying to explain but falling short of a proper description. Perhaps it's easiest to say that we have seen a visible sign of God's Victory over death. Satan and the Culture of Death have given it their "best shot" to destroy these parents and their children. The Victory is the Lord's and we have

seen it. WOW! So, when you see a woman or man holding an "I Regret My Abortion" sign, think of it as a visible sign of the Victory over death and rejoice.

### **A Sermon on the Song of Songs By Saint Bernard, Abbot**

Where can the weak find a place of firm security and peace, except in the wounds of the Savior? The world rages, the flesh is heavy, and the devil lays his snares, but I do not fall, for my feet are planted on firm rock. I may have sinned gravely. My conscience would be distressed, but it would not be in turmoil, for I would recall the wounds of the Lord: he was wounded for our iniquities. What sin is there so deadly that it cannot be pardoned by the death of Christ? And so if I bear in mind this strong, effective remedy, I can never again be terrified by the malignancy of sin. Surely the man who said: My sin is too great to merit pardon, was wrong. . . They pierced his hands and feet and opened his side with a spear. Through the openings of these wounds I may drink honey from the rock and oil from the hardest stone: that is, I may taste and see that the Lord is sweet.

But the piercing nail has become a key to unlock the door that I may see the good will of the Lord. . . the nail and the wound cry out that God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself. The sword pierced his soul and came close to his heart, so that he might be able to feel compassion for me in my weaknesses.

Through these sacred wounds we can see the secret of his Heart, the great mystery of love, the sincerity of his mercy with which he visited us from on high. Where have your love, your mercy, your compassion shone out more luminously than in your wounds, sweet gentle Lord of Mercy? . . . Where sin abounded grace has overflowed. And if the Lord's mercies are from all ages forever, I too will sing of the mercies of the Lord forever.

### **A Note from the Pastoral Director**

Brothers and Sisters,

As we continue to work together to heal the wounds of abortion, the more we inform ourselves about the nature of those wounds, the more effective we become at facilitating the healing. At the last training conference we had for Rachel's Vineyard, I presented a workshop about the many ways that women are wounded in the abortion clinics. (I will be repeating that workshop at the upcoming conference in July.) It is not only the procedure itself that brings deep wounds; it is also the behavior of the abortionist and his/her staff, their incompetence and malpractice, their lies and pressure, their sexual abuse, and much more.

Though it is tough reading, the book *Lime 5* gives important insights into the kind of unregulated, unscrupulous environment that is the rule rather than the exception in abortion clinics nationwide. (You can request a copy from me.) As we face up to these evils which compound the fundamental wound of abortion itself, we can recommit ourselves to understanding all the levels of hurt that our RV participants are dealing with.
