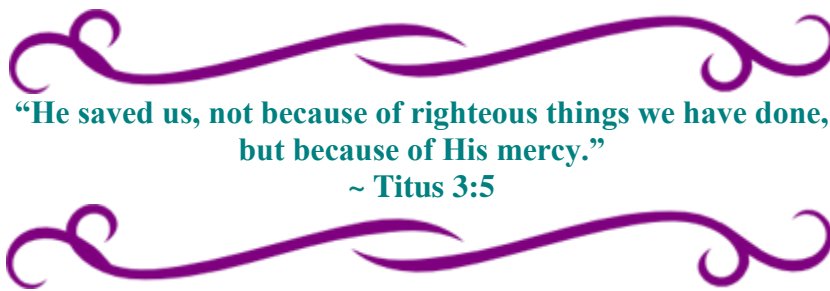

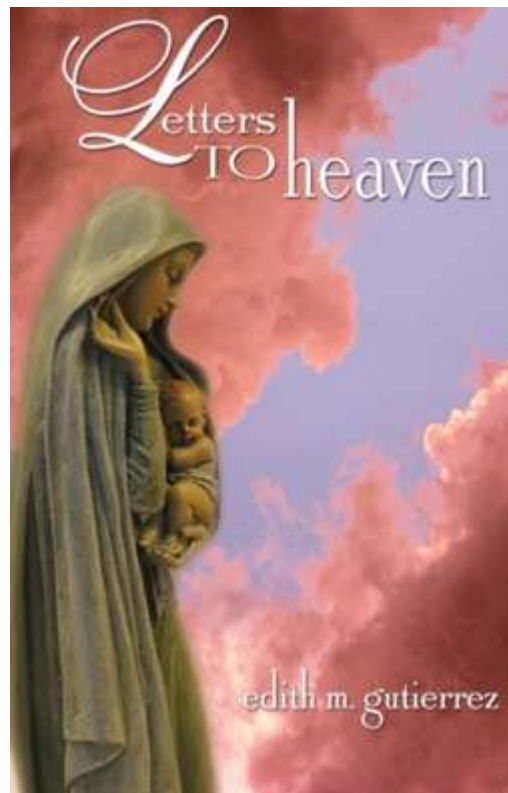

### **Message from the Pastoral Director**

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

With the anniversary of Roe vs. Wade, the various large marches and rallies across the country, and the Sanctity of Life Sunday observances in various churches, January is a month when more people think about the abortion issue than perhaps at any other time of year. And we know that many of these reminders will trigger various painful reactions in those who have lost children to abortion or in some way participated in it.

Our ministry, as you know, helps people understand the signs and symptoms of abortion trauma, and more importantly, helps them see the way forward to healing and new hope. And it is in Christ alone that we can find that healing. That doesn't mean that it's only in *spiritual exercises* that we find the healing; rather, it means only in *Christ*, who works both through spiritual exercises and the psychological sciences.
