Thanks Donald Trump for the Kick in the Teeth to Pro-Lifers in Abortion Healing Ministries

A media firestorm erupted on March 30th with Donald Trump's recent very unhelpful statement about penalties for women if abortion were once again illegal in the U.S. Trump was baited by Chris Matthews of MSNBC during a town hall event where he made those statements. But the exchange revealed that Trump has not thought through the issues involved with unplanned pregnancy and abortion decisions, and is lacking in some essential perspective and education on the topic.

Mr. Trump and his advisors would do well to spend some time reading the testimonies on the Silent No More Awareness Campaign website to better understand the impact of abortion on women and men before talking about hypothetical penalties for women if abortion is once again an illegal activity in the united states. Trump fails to mention any penalties for the fathers of these unborn children who in many cases play a very important role in the decision of women to have an abortion.

Those who support abortion rights and their allies in media and entertainment are fond of painting a negative caricature of pro-lifers as angry and judgmental fundamentalists. I have been humbled and blessed to see the love and practical help that pro-life advocates share with not only pregnant and young mothers and fathers but to anyone who has participated in the death of an unborn child.

Fr. Frank Pavone shares that being pro-life means being pro-woman:

To be pro-life means to be pro-woman. It doesn't mean that we love the babies and we forget about the mothers. What it means is very simple: Why can't we love them both? Protect them both? Welcome and care for them both? We can and together we will.

April 2016


Rachel's Vineyard was represented at the Supreme Court twice during the month of March. As you know, the Court heard the abortion case out of Texas regarding the regulation of the abortionists and their facilities. This was the case in which Priests for Life submitted a *friend of the court* brief talking about the testimonies of those hurt by abortion and healed by efforts like Rachel's Vineyard. Well, the argument of our brief and the reference to the testimonies of those who regret their abortion and were hurt by it **were mentioned in the oral arguments before the court!**

Moreover, after those oral arguments, I attended a private reception with the attorneys who argued the case before the court, those who wrote the Texas law that was being defended, and other pro-life activists, leaders and legal experts. Remarks were shared by several of us, and I mentioned to all of those present the courageous witness given by those wounded and healed after abortion. We all prayed for the whole family of Rachel's Vineyard throughout the world. I also asked, during the Q and A session with those who had prepared and argued the case, about the importance of their testimonies, and they indicated that they are a very important part of this case and of the pro-life movement generally.

Then, later in March, the oral arguments were held in the case regarding the HHS mandate, in which Priests for Life is a petitioner before the court. That went well also, and Rachel's Vineyard was well represented at the prayer vigil the night before and the rally outside the Court the day of the arguments.

Janet and I were also at EWTN for more TV taping, and, as usual, we made sure the viewers were reminded of the ongoing work of Rachel's Vineyard in the Church and in the world! So thank you for all you do to spread this message of life and healing!

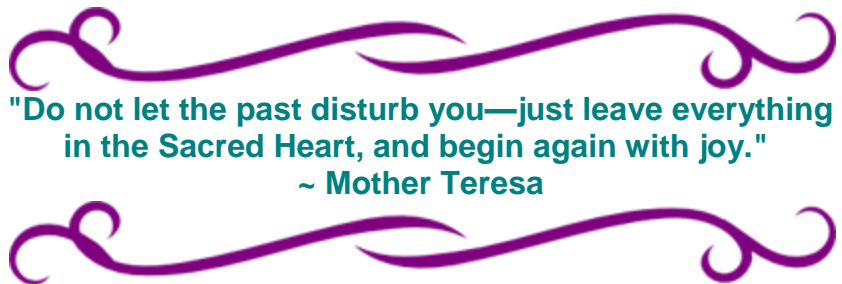
