END OF YEAR REVIEW OF 2025 ACTIVITIES

Introduction

Priests for Life, the largest Catholic organization focused on ending abortion, is actually a family of interrelated projects and programs, including *Gospel of Life Ministries*, *Rachel's Vineyard*, the *Silent No More Awareness Campaign*, *ProLife Vote*, *Deacons for Life*, *Seminarians for Life*, *Missionaries of the Gospel of Life*, *Civil Rights for the Unborn*, *Stand True Youth Outreach*, *ProLife Prayers*, and *EndAbortion TV*.

The key leaders who constitute our team include Fr. Denis Wilde, O.S.A., Janet Morana (co-founder of the Silent No More Campaign), Dr. Alveda King (niece of Martin Luther King, Jr.), Dr. Theresa and Kevin Burke (co-founders of Rachel's Vineyard), Bryan Kemper (founder of Stand True), and others who work with the ministries that comprise the Priests for Life Family.

Pro-life Leader Frank Pavone serves fulltime as National Director and Fr. Denis Wilde, OSA serves as a fulltime Pastoral Associate. Various priests and deacons around the country serve in a part-time capacity.

Overview of Activities: Our Priests for Life Family of Ministries

Direct Ministry to Priests

Our priests offer clergy seminars in dioceses, training materials for preaching and counseling, and individual consultation for clergy on the pro-life dimensions of their ministry.

Deacons for Life

Deacons have a particular calling to bring God's Word into the world and to exercise the ministry of charity. Their opportunities to promote the Gospel of Life are uniquely valuable. We train, encourage, and mobilize them, too.

Seminarians for Life

Those who are training for the ministry need to know, from the beginning, the ways in which they can prepare to be effective advocates for life. We therefore reach out to seminarians and provide them the tools and the example by which they can proclaim, celebrate, and serve the Gospel of Life. This involves encountering seminarians in the course of our travels, individual consultations, and online resources.

Missionaries of the Gospel of Life (pro-life spirituality for clergy and laity)

Being pro-life, and doing pro-life activities, is not a hobby or simply rooted in an ideology or political platform. It is a *spirituality*, and is rooted in our discipleship. We therefore teach both clergy and laity the spirituality of being a Missionary of the Gospel of Life, and how that spirituality shapes pro-life strategy and tactics.

Rachel's Vineyard

Part of the Priests for Life Family is the world's largest ministry for healing after abortion. Rachel's Vineyard holds hundreds of retreats each year for men and women who have lost children to abortion.

Silent No More Awareness Campaign

A project of Priests for Life and Anglicans for Life, the Silent No More Awareness Campaign is the world's largest mobilization of men and women who have lost a child to abortion, have experienced healing, and now want to share their testimony. The Campaign promotes healing and a greater awareness of the wounds abortion causes.

Civil Rights for the Unborn

Dr. Alveda King, niece of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., and a Board member of the Priests for Life, founded Civil Rights for the Unborn, which reaches the African-American community and all citizens with the theme that the civil rights movement of today is the pro-life movement!

Hispanic Outreach

Both in the US and around the world, we are assisting communities of Hispanic heritage to build the Culture of Life.

Gospel of Life Ministries

Gospel of Life Ministries brings to an interdenominational audience the wide variety of pro-life work that Priests for Life does.

Youth Outreach

Bryan Kemper, is the founder and president of Stand True Ministries, a Christ-centered pro-life outreach determined to awaken the youth of this country and share the message of life and the Gospel of Christ. He has spent years reaching out to youth and encouraging this generation to get involved, and now he continues that outreach with Stand True Ministries, which the youth outreach of Priests for Life.

EndAbortion.TV

EndAbortion.TV is our broadcast ministry (radio, television, internet, social media and podcasting), consisting of daily live and pre-recorded programs, interviews by the members of our pastoral team, and short spots provided to media outlets around the world, including EWTN, Bott Radio Network, Radio Maria, and many more.

ProLife Prayers

All we do is rooted in prayer, which both undergirds and fosters productive action. At ProLifePrayers.org, we offer prolife prayers for all occasions and foster prayer campaigns throughout the year, corresponding to various liturgical and secular seasons and holidays.

Street Activism

Priests for Life has an outreach for Street Activism, by which we promote marches, prayer vigils at abortion facilities, protests of the abortion industry, life chains, Face the Truth tours, and various other actions of public witness.

ProLife Vote

As both citizens of heaven and citizens of this world, we are called to exercise political responsibility to elect leaders who will defend life, and to sustain those leaders on the right path. Through our c-4 lobbying entity called "Prolife Vote," we teach and mobilize citizens to make a difference in the voting booth for the protection of the unborn.

Networking Leaders

Priests for Life occupies a strategic place of unity in the pro-life movement. We foster relations between leaders, groups, and ministries. We facilitate strategic planning sessions on every level, as well as leadership retreats and seminars. Priests for Life coordinates the quarterly meetings of national pro-life leaders in the United States and periodic strategy summits whereby national pro-life leaders come together at our headquarters for several days.

SOME HIGHLIGHTS OF 2025 ACTIVITIES

1. Training of Clergy

Our National Director and other members of our pastoral team are regular speaker at training seminars for clergy all over the country. The Liberty Pastors, for example, is a national network of pastors that holds several national “training camps” each year, attracting hundreds of pastors from across the Body of Christ. In 2025, our National Director presented in several cities to these pastors the resources and strategies of Priests for Life for activating the Churches to protect the unborn, heal those wounded by abortion, and shape public policy.

Dr. Theresa Burke of Rachel’s Vineyard likewise made presentations to clergy in various parts of the nation.

Also, Priests for Life, with the collaboration of Deacon Keith Fournier and other deacons, increased the promotion of “Deacons for Life” to equip the nation’s deacons to be even more effective in prolife ministry.

In the Spring of 2025, Priests for Life launched a new guide for clergy and laity for the Lenten season, connecting its themes to the defense of the unborn.

In the Fall of 2025, we released a “Primer” on why and how only the Church can end abortion. This was part of our effort to re-emphasize the primary mission of Priests for Life, ***to make the Church prolife again.***

2. Good Shepherd Project

The “Good Shepherd Project” (www.TheGoodShepherdProject.com), continued this year, with renewed efforts to assist the clergy to teach, counsel and preach regarding abortion and the defense of the unborn, and to promote and urgently invite people to the healing and reconciliation available after abortion.

Monthly live broadcasts feature the priests, deacons, and other experts on our pastoral team addressing clergy directly about how to deal effectively with the abortion issue (in prayer, preaching, teaching and parish/school activities).

The broadcast also explains to laity how to encourage and equip the clergy on these matters.

We also invited various priests around the nation to appear on our broadcasts, tape endorsements of the work of Priests for Life to encourage their brother priests, and be interviewed for the “Priest Profiles,” a section of our regular newsletter that we re-launched in 2025.

3. Liturgical resources

On our websites and via regular emails, faxes, newsletters, social media, and onsite seminars, we equip the clergy with resources for praying and preaching on the abortion issue. These include homily hints, General intercessions and more.

In 2025 we completed an upgrade to the content and format of these liturgical resources, which remain one of the most frequently visited sections of our website.

The book *Proclaiming the Message of Life* contains pro-life commentary on the Sunday readings for the entirety of Years A, B and C. And on ProLifeLiturgy.org, clergy can find short videos with ideas for elements of a pro-life homily.

4. Healing After Abortion

In various ways, Priests for Life continued leading the way in programs offering healing after abortion.

First of all, within the family of Priests for Life ministries is Rachel’s Vineyard (www.RachelsVineyard.org), the largest ministry in the world for healing after abortion.

This ministry, of which Pro-life Leader Frank Pavone serves as Chairman of the Board, continued to hold around the world its retreats based on the Word of God, the sacraments, and sound psychological research. New sites continued to be established domestically and internationally throughout 2025.

Secondly, Priests for Life co-founded, along with Anglicans for Life, the **Silent No More Awareness Campaign**, which is the world’s largest mobilization of those who have lost children to abortion and share their testimonies of hurt and healing.

Throughout 2025, the Campaign continued its public witness at gatherings and online, its multiple educational and broadcast initiatives, and the internal training of its regional coordinators through monthly Zoom calls.

Our healing initiatives are part and parcel of the Abortion Recovery Coalition, which brings together similar ministries and provides a monthly opportunity for dialogue, shared prayer and discussion.

In 2025, we drew special attention to the observance of *Abortion Recovery Awareness Month* in April. Priests for Life developed a toolkit for individuals, Churches and organizations to use to promote awareness of healing. Special educational and pastoral broadcasts and communications to the Churches were also among the tools utilized.

At our meetings of prolife leaders in 2025, we also highlighted the researchers who have provided the prolife movement valuable insights into the harmful effects of abortion, and gave them an opportunity to update their peers.

5. Elections 2025

Priests for Life, through our c-4 ProLife Vote, was active in the elections of 2025, including key races in New Jersey, Virginia, and also the Wisconsin Supreme Court. All of these elections had consequences for the abortion issue, which we emphasized.

6. Prolife Vote

We continued conducting in-person and online trainings in how to influence elections, and called people to action to support good prolife legislation and oppose bad legislation both on the state and federal levels.

Our broadcasts, social media, email and snail mail communications, along with preaching in Churches, speaking at conferences, and participating in regular conference calls, gave leaders, activists, and citizens nationwide an opportunity to examine the issues, know the candidates, and utilize the voting process in the most effective way.

As part of this activity, we continued our collaboration with the America First Policy Institute, which consists largely of former Trump Administration officials who created and implemented many pro-life, pro-family, pro-freedom policies.

7. Bringing Prayer into Politics

Our National Director is regularly invited to lead prayer and reflections on national prayer calls organized by the Republican National Committee and various other political and conservative groups and movements. This happened on a regular basis throughout 2025.

Moreover, he was also called upon to lead events of prayer and reflection around the state and the country for political groups.

8. Equipping Legislators

Our National Director is an advisor to the National Association of Christian Lawmakers. In that capacity, he has met with lawmakers from across the country at the semi-annual meetings of this organization and addressed them regarding prolife legislative strategy and the status of the battle to protect the unborn.

One of our new allies in the US Congress is Texas Congressman Brandon Gill, with whom we communicated regularly on prolife strategy.

Priests for Life was also a catalyst for the national Lobbying Day held in March of 2025 to press for the de-funding of the abortion industry, which came to pass successfully in the signing of the “Big Beautiful Bill” on July 4th.

9. America 250

Priests for Life and National Director Frank Pavone were invited by the America First Policy Institute and the US Department of Education to be part of the Civics Education initiative of “America250,” making plans for the year-long celebration of America’s 250th birthday in 2026.

Our participation in these meeting during 2025 brought our prolife expertise to bear on the fact that the Declaration of Independence declares the right to life as given by God, and government’s duty to secure that right. Any proper understanding of the principles on which America was founded involves an understanding of the foundational right to life, and how it applies to the unborn.

10. Religious Liberty Commission

Priests for Life and our National Director Frank Pavone were invited to participate in the regular meetings of the Religious Liberty Commission, established by President Trump to devise new recommendations for future presidential actions to further secure and advance religious liberty, which is essential to our ability to secure the right to life.

Along with these meetings, Priests for Life was also represented at various meetings and events of the Faith Office, established in the White House, including a meeting and prayer time with the President in the Oval Office.

11. The Courts

As we have done in the past, Priests for Life helped lead educational efforts regarding court cases in 2025 regarding abortion, including the *First Choice* case in the US Supreme Court, for which oral arguments were held in the Fall of 2025.

Priests for Life and our National Director Frank Pavone were invited to take part in regular consultations and meetings with the Judicial Action Group, a national effort to ensure that the best candidates for the bench are brought forward and supported. We also participated in a national prayer event in Washington DC to mark the opening of the new term of the Supreme Court in October, and to consecrate the Court and its Justices to God.

Priests for Life helped organize meetings of prolife attorneys and conduct public educational efforts to advance the understanding that the right to life is not only in our Declaration of Independence, but also in the Constitution itself, in the 5th and 14th amendments.

Finally, Priests for Life was asked to assist in the production of a documentary by Vincent Fusca, an eyewitness to the Butler, PA assassination attempt on President Trump. This documentary is aimed to deepen the appreciation of our citizens of how God's hand has preserved America miraculously throughout our history.

12. Florida March for the Preborn

In conjunction with a new Florida-based organization, the *Defending Life Alliance of Florida*, of which our National Director is a founding Board member, and with Florida Right to Life, Priests for Life worked to organize a statewide march for life in Jacksonville called the *Florida March for the Preborn*, which was held in early 2025. During the rest of the year we planned for a January 2026 Florida march and prolife banquet.

13. Travels and Presentations

Priests for Life remained in the forefront of being physically present at pro-life conferences, prayer vigils, rallies, Churches and schools as our pastoral team responded to invitations from pro-life groups large and small. We serve pro-life groups, schools, dioceses, and Churches of all denominations without charge for our services or materials.

Many of the travels of 2025 were educational and prayer events with pastors and government officials. Others were standard annual prolife conferences and marches or special invitations.

Events included national conferences of pregnancy center directors/staff, the National Right to Life Convention, the 40 Days for Life Symposium, the March for Life and Walk for Life West Coast, various state marches (Michigan, Florida) and various political/conservative conferences (CPAC, Road to Majority, Turning Point USA, America First Policy Institute, Council for National Policy), pastors' training conferences (with Liberty Pastors), the National Association of Christian Lawmakers, Christian music festivals, pregnancy center banquets and more.

We also participated by means of both taped and live video at other events and national prayer calls.

14. Pro-life Women In History Month

Once again this year, Priests for Life designated March as Prolife Women in History Month, launching a website on which, for each day of the month, a different woman who made a significant impact in the battle to protect the unborn is highlighted.

15. Essay Contest

Priests for Life once again sponsored a national prolife essay contest for students in junior high, high school and college. In January we awarded the three winners of the contest at our National Prayer Service, and at the end of the year we announced the winners for the 2025 contest, to be honored at the January 2026 prayer service.

16. Online Broadcasting and New Programming

Our online broadcasting effort from our professional TV studio at our Priests for Life headquarters brings our programming to multiple social media platforms as well as video-sharing channels including ROKU, Google Play, Android TV, Apple TV and Apple IOS. Our programming is also seen on other broadcasting networks like Right Side Broadcasting Network.

Our regular programming includes:

Praying for America – a half-hour show each week commenting on the political landscape from a Biblical perspective and preparing voters for upcoming elections

The Living Word – Frank Pavone gives pro-life reflections on the daily readings.

Pro-life PrimeTime News – giving the latest news on abortion and the pro-life movement

Just Ask Janet – our Executive Director interviews powerful guests making a difference for the pro-life movement.

Janet Reacts – a segment by our Executive Director Janet Morana giving a quick response to news developments or public commentary on the abortion issue.

EndAbortionUS – our National Director and Executive Director share strategic insights, talking points, and projects related to ending abortion.

Prolife Primetime – National Director Frank Pavone delves deeply into various aspects of the abortion issue.

Daily Diary – Frank Pavone shares what he did each day and night, hour by hour, in a spirit of transparency and accountability.

These programs also air on our podcast, called the *End Abortion Podcast*, which continues to rank as the number 1 podcast on abortion.

17. Priests for Life in the Media

In addition to our own broadcasting, our pastoral team conducted numerous interviews for the national Christian, conservative, and secular print, radio, podcast, television and online media. We continued in 2025 to produce a weekly program on Radio Maria, and to send radio spots to multiple outlets.

In particular, our National Director has been a regular commentator on Newsmax, and on Real America's Voice, American Family Radio, Virgin Most Powerful Radio, the Prolife Team podcast, and many other outlets.

Throughout the year, Priests for Life team members continued to write opinion pieces that were published regularly by outlets like Newsmax.com, The Gateway Pundit, The Washington Times, LifeNews.com, Washington Examiner, The Daily Citizen, Catholic Online, and many others.

Our National Director and conservative commentator Bishop Aubrey Shines planned in 2025 a new podcast called *Truth Uncensored*.

18. Social Media

Throughout the year, Priests for Life placed a high priority on utilizing the power of social media not only to spread the pro-life message but to identify, unite and activate like-minded people for the pro-life cause.

All our platforms grew exponentially and consistently throughout the year, giving us one of the largest reaches in the world for the pro-life message.

In particular, live broadcasting on these platforms, as well as immediate commentary on breaking news, were key factors in this growth.

19. Coalitions of Pro-life Leaders

Throughout 2025, Priests for Life continued to organize and build up effective working coalitions of the national pro-life groups, and coordinate their meetings, held in Washington DC two times during the year, a third time online, and a three-day meeting held at our headquarters in Titusville, Florida.

In between those in-person meetings we also led numerous leaders' meetings via Zoom.

We created various committees among the leaders to focus and specialize on particular areas of concern in the prolife movement and report status updates and recommendations to the wider movement.

We also helped to network and equip state leaders.
