Ms. Tomeo on alternate weeks for the show's 13th season.

Viewers have gotten used to the show tackling hot-button issues and this new season is no exception. The hosts will address the dangers to women of the resurgent Equal Rights Amendment; gender dysphoria and the transgender craze; the physical and spiritual benefits of fasting; same-sex marriage; how social media harms teens; domestic violence and what the Catholic Church should be doing about it, and the dangers of in vitro fertilization.

Guests will include Erin Thielman, mom of a son with Down syndrome; Dr. Michelle Cratella of the American Academy of Pediatricians, and Dr. Mary Healy, a professor at Sacred Heart Major Seminary in Detroit.

The broadcast date has not yet been announced but new shows should begin airing in late spring.

"Even though our taping was delayed, I'm so pleased and grateful we can continue to offer such a wide variety of guests and relevant topics to our viewers," Mrs. Morana said. "I'm confident that anyone who tunes in will be entertained, educated and empowered by what they see."

We're Not Colorblind, co-authored by Alveda King Stresses there's only one race: The Human Race

With the U.S. in jeopardy of fracturing along simmering fault lines, authors Alveda King and Ginger Howard have released their new book, ***We're Not Colorblind: Healing the Racial Divide***.

Evangelist King is a longtime civil rights and pro-life activist. She is the niece of Rev. Martin Luther King Jr., and the full-time director of Civil Rights for the Unborn for Priests for Life.

Mrs. Howard has been involved in Georgia politics for two decades. She is a former radio host and founded a political consulting company to help elect Christian candidates to public office.

The book, described by its authors as a "journalized journey," invites readers to think about race from a biblical perspective.

We're Not Colorblind emphasizes that despite differences of ethnicity, creed and

political beliefs, all people are members of a single race - the human race. The concept of separate human races is socially engineered by human beings; science and religion paint a different picture.

Father Frank Pavone, National Director of Priests for Life, called the book "an important step in our constant struggle to remember that our human dignity, and our fundamental right to life, unite us all, and that recognizing that is essential to peace."

Evangelist King said solutions can be found even to the most intractable problems if every one of us accepts our responsibility to bringing about reconciliation.

"The answers to the societal problems we face are anything but simple, and our personal stories and national history are layered with complexity," the authors wrote in the introduction. "Peeling back those layers to discover the roots of our pain will be vulnerable and uncomfortable but without conversations to air out the wounds of the past, the dark depths of bitterness and fear will remain."

A Pro-Life Lent

"Repent and believe the Good News!"

The urgent call to repent marks the Lenten season, just as it marks the preaching ministry of St. John the Baptist (Mt.3:2), of the Lord Jesus (Mt.4:17), and of Peter and the Apostles (Acts 2:37-38). It is a call to make a conscious and free choice to turn away from sin, which leads to death, and embrace the Gospel, which leads to life. It is, in fact, the full flowering of the call Moses issued in Deuteronomy 30:19, "I have set before you life and death...Choose life!"

One of my favorite Lenten Gospel passages is that of the man born blind (John 9). We see here the drama of the will to accept or reject the call of Christ. The man born blind receives his physical sight early in the story, but the rest of the drama traces the birth of his spiritual sight. At first, he calls Jesus a man (v.11); then a prophet (v.17); then one who is "from God" (v.33), and finally, "Lord" (v.38). He comes to see who Jesus is, because he has a willingness to believe. "Who is he, sir, that I may believe in him?" (v.36).

This attitude of willingness stands in stark contrast to the stubbornness and bad will of the Pharisees. Though confronted with the same evidence of the physical healing, they try to explain away that evidence through their interrogations of the man and his parents, and then by portraying Jesus as a sinner, and finally by literally throwing the evidence out the door by ejecting

the healed man from their midst (see v.34).

The drama is repeated every day as our society struggles with the "Culture of Death," which shows itself fundamentally in the ongoing tragedy of abortion. The evidence is the same for all to see, made clearer than ever by genetics and fetology, that abortion kills a human being. Some receive that evidence and, with a willing heart, choose life. Others show the stubbornness of the Pharisees and cling to their own ideology. For me the starkest example of this was the day a group of pro-life people conducted a wake for an aborted baby in front of an abortion facility. The baby, the size of a hand, was visible in a small white casket. Some pro-abortion demonstrators looked at the child, and a pro-lifer challenged them, "Look at the evidence right before your eyes. This is a baby!" Believe it or not, the person's response was "That's your opinion!!"


Not to know the child in the womb is not a sin. But the refusal to know is. Jesus declares to the Pharisees at the end of the drama of John 9, "If you were blind, there would be no sin in that, but 'We see,' you say, and your sin remains" (v.41).

Today, the Democrat Party in America, and its political leaders, are deeply guilty of this kind of blindness, and need to repent. They both tolerate and promote the killing of children by abortion, and then get all righteous and angry when children are killed by gun violence. Public officials who do not have enough of a conscience to oppose the killing of babies do not belong in public office.

"Repent and believe the Good News!" What good news? The good news, in the words of The Gospel of Life, that "life is always a good...manifestation of God in the world, a sign of His presence, a trace of His glory" (#34). This Lent, let us choose life again!


