Priests for Life present for historic Supreme Court case that could curtail abortion in U.S.

Priests for Life was well represented in the nation's capital on Dec. 1, when the U.S. Supreme Court heard the historic abortion case Dobbs vs. Jackson Women's Health Organization. The court will decide the constitutionality of a Mississippi law that protects babies from abortion from 15 weeks' gestation.

Father Frank Pavone organized a morning press conference the previous day, Nov. 30, at

the National Press Club and a livestream of the event that was broadcast on Priests for Life's streaming platforms and by the Washington Examiner.

Father Frank also spoke at an event at the Lincoln Memorial sponsored by the Justice Foundation, at which a scroll with hundreds of thousands of signatures was rolled out, decrying abortion as a crime against humanity. After that he spoke at an afternoon press conference in front of the Supreme Court.

That same day he gathered with pro-life activists to pray at the DC Planned Parenthood, took part in a Face the Truth tour (people holding signs on the DC streets showing what an aborted baby looks like) and was present with other pro-life leaders at two different dinner events.

That evening before the oral arguments saw a candlelight prayer vigil outside the Supreme Court. Father Frank and Priests for Life Youth Outreach Director Bryan Kemper offered prayers at the gathering.

Father Frank, Bryan and several Priests for Life staffers were out in front of the court bright and early on the day of the oral arguments. U.S. Capitol Police had erected fences to keep pro-life and pro-abortion protesters separated. The pro-life crowd outnumbered the pro-aborts by a margin of three to one. Leaders from national pro-life organizations were in attendance. Father Frank provided on-air commentary from the scene for Right Side Broadcasting Network. Then Fr. Frank led the final part of the rally in front of the Court and provided his perspective on how the oral arguments went.

Our broadcasting of these events quickly reached over three million viewers.

The consensus of pro-life legal experts and pro-life leaders who listened to the arguments was that the

conservative majority on the court seems inclined to allow the Mississippi law to stand, which would open the door for other states to pass pre-viability laws to protect babies from abortion. It's also possible the court could decide to overturn the 1973 Roe v. Wade decision and allow the states even greater leeway to protect the unborn.

A decision on the case could come as late as June 2022, but nobody knows for sure. As happened in Roe itself, an earlier decision would allow legislatures to do the work of their 2022 session with the Court's guidance in mind.

be effectively neutralized and the legality of abortion determined by the states, the midterms could shape up to be more important than ever, not only as a referendum on the Biden administration, but for the pro-life movement in terms of electing pro-life state legislatures and pro-life governors that can pass critical legislation on a state level. This is where you come in.

One does not need to be a paid campaign staffer or the press secretary on television to make a difference. You, an everyday person in your community, hold sway within your sphere of influence. Perhaps this is your co-workers, your Christmas card list, the parents on your child's soccer team, your Bible study group, your neighbors, family, or friends. It is amazing how many people may be pro-life but truly do not know how those values align with the views of the candidates. It is amazing how many people may not know when Election Day is, especially for a non-presidential election such as a primary or a midterm, or where their polling place may be, or may have just moved and have not taken the time to register to vote yet. People with busy lives juggling work and family may not have the time to fully research the candidates, but very much want a pro-life person elected, and you can be the one to help fill in those gaps so those people can cast informed votes aligning with their pre-existing values.

You do not necessarily need to have the hard conversation with a fervent pro-choicer and win him or her over. It is often more of getting the people who are already pro-life up to speed on where the candidates stand on the issue and motivated to actually show up to vote on Election Day.

It can be a simple conversation with someone in your sphere of influence - whether a phone call, text message, e-mail, social media post, or a visit to someone's home. It can be

Pro-life is the New Punk Rock recalls the beginning of the pro-life youth movement

Priests for Life Youth Outreach Director Bryan Kemper has released a new memoir that recounts his conversion to the pro-life cause and his integral role in bringing young people into the movement.

Pro-life is the New Punk Rock: A History of the Pro-Life Youth Movement, published by Priests for Life Publishing, is a deeply personal and moving account of Bryan's difficult childhood, his descent into drug use and his salvation experience that began with a drug overdose that should have proved fatal.

Bryan talks about the founding of Rock for Life, which drew young Christians into the pro-life cause by inviting them to concerts and opening their eyes to the truth of abortion. He also goes into the early days of Stand True, which he founded, and how the singer of the band Green Day accidentally increased the organization's visibility during a music festival.

The book recalls days when the media was more willing to listen to pro-life voices. MTV publicized some of Rock for Life's concerts and the comedian and talk show host Bill Maher had Bryan on as a guest numerous times on his show on ABC.

His introduction to Father Frank Pavone and Priests for Life is also covered in the book. Bryan was "under cover" as a pro-abortion protester at the time, so he apologized to Father Frank while relentlessly heckling him at a March for Life event in D.C. In his foreword, Father Frank said readers should look at the book "not just as something to read, but as an adventure to follow."

"Abortion must end," he wrote. "As Bryan's story will show you, the voices of the unborn must cry out in our hearts, on our lips, in our homes, in the streets, in our churches, in the legislatures, in the voting booths, in our businesses, in our music, art, and literature, in the abortion facilities, at public events, in private conversations, in every nook and cranny of earth and in the heights of heaven!"

Abortion Kills Babies. Protecting Them is an Issue for Men Too, Not Just Women

"Shhhh! Men can't say anything about this!"

So read a comment I saw recently on social media from a pro-abortion woman trying to silence a man about abortion.

For decades, abortion advocates have tried to justify abortion by isolating it. They want to isolate it in the realm of privacy, and solely the privacy of the mother.

It's a "woman's issue," after all. And according to them, it's only that.

If we are to overcome abortion, we must overcome the isolation, and the rhetoric of isolation. It is not simply about the woman. It's about the family. It's about restoring the supportive relationships within the family, as God intended it, to be the "sanctuary of life," as the Catholic Church refers to it, the community of persons which is meant to provide the stable framework for welcoming and raising new life.


And it's about a Culture of Life in which every citizen understands that we have all been entrusted to the care of one another, and that we all share responsibility for innocent blood shed upon our land.

Yet we as pro-life activists have to be careful that we don't unintentionally contribute to the isolation of abortion as "just a woman's issue."

This can happen if we take a good thing - namely, raising the female voices of pro-life advocacy - and separate it from its context - namely, the advocacy of human rights that is the right and duty of every human being equally.

Abortion is the killing of a child. Protecting a child is just as much the business of a man as of a woman. Speaking up for the voiceless, and defending the vulnerable, is not a task that rises or falls with gender. It is everyone's responsibility, equally.
