Election "Day" is here! Use the Ten-Step Voter Plan

Six states opened early voting in September and most states will follow suit throughout this month.

Vermont leads the way this month, with voting taking place from Oct. 1 through Nov. 4. California, Montana and Nebraska open their polling places on Oct. 7, with New Mexico, Ohio and Wyoming following on Oct. 8, and Arizona opening up Oct. 9. The rest of the early-voting states will follow.

This election is too important for pro-lifers to stay at home - we must come out in force to support Republicans and support life

For pro-lifers and all Americans who care about the future of our nation, it is key to support Republican candidates, despite imperfections they have and frustrations we have.

If Senate Democrats somehow find themselves with a filibuster-proof majority, they will pass the radical Women's Health Protection Act, which would do away with every single abortion law on every level of government. Born-alive protections for newborn survivors of abortion? Gone. Parental consent and notification? Gone. Gestational limits on abortion? Gone. You get the idea.

Our nation would once again be soaked in the blood of the unborn.

The Democrats also will set their sights on other goals - goals that have thus far been unattainable because of the Republicans. The For the People ACT would do away with free and fair elections and, with a Democrat majority, non-citizens could very well gain the right to vote.

Any concept of a border would be thrown out the window; women will continue to be canceled as the bizarre transgender movement finds even more allies among the Democrats. Ever-increasing numbers of girls and women in sports will lose titles and scholarships to mediocre male athletes who pretend to be women just to win medals.

Parents will lose all rights to raise their children and, indeed, lose custody of children unless they go along with their minor child's gender identification. And gender-mutilating surgeries will be performed on ever-younger children.

All of this - and more - seems insane, and yet all of it is within reach if Democrats come away from the 2024 elections with

In many states, voters will receive mail-in ballots, which they can mail back or deposit in designated locations. In some of these states, regular polling sites also will be open to drop off mail-in ballots. Oregon is mail-in voting only and there is no option there for early voting.

Along with choosing candidates, voters in a number of states also will be deciding on whether or not a "right to abortion" should be invented and written in to their constitutions. Vote "NO" on these amendments. See StateBallotInitiatives.com for the latest updates.

Every pro-life vote is more important than ever this year. We each need to have a plan to vote, and here is a suggested ten-point plan:

1. Check your Voter Registration at CheckYourVoterRegistration.com. Make sure all the details are correct and fix what has to be fixed.
2. Visit your state election website and find the information for your county and voting district. Verify your regular polling place.
3. Find out on that same site when early voting begins in your state and county, and where the polling place for you would be for early voting. (It may not be the same as your usual polling place.)
4. Mark your calendar to vote as soon as possible after early voting begins. Choose the day on which you will vote.
5. If circumstances require you to use an absentee ballot, find out from your state election website or your local board of elections when and how they are available, arrange to get yours, and decide what date you're going to fill it out.
6. If you will vote in person, figure out what time of day you will go and how you will get there.
7. Have a Plan B in case something happens that day with sickness, weather, car trouble, mechanical problems at the polling place, etc. Decide in advance what alternate day you will be able to go vote.
8. Determine if there are others who can come with you.
9. Find your ballot in order to see exactly what it will look like. Study it carefully. Use your state election website, or use Ballotpedia.org, or use iVoterGuide.com. Research each candidate and ballot initiative.
10. Find out from your state election website or your local board of elections how you can track your ballot once it is cast.

Friends, it's not just that every **vote** counts; it's that every **ballot** counts. Consider becoming a poll watcher. Contact your local Republican Party office about this. You can also apply to be a poll **worker**. Ask your Board of Elections about that.

300 pastors enlist to do battle in war for America's survival

Liberty Pastors, an initiative operating under The Remnant Alliance, brought about 300 pastors together this past summer in Frisco, Texas, to pray together, share meals and listen to experts in the intersection of religion and politics.

I was privileged to speak to the pastors about how the Church responds to abortion. I shared the stage with Pastor Paul Blair, who leads Liberty Pastors; with Pastor Jim Garlow, renowned for his role years ago in the successful passage of Proposition 8 that defended traditional marriage in California, and with Steve Deace, a conservative media personality.

Also on the agenda was Gen. Michael Flynn, an American hero who was a target of the weaponized government.

One of the key themes was that the political divide in our nation is not just a competition of policies, but of ideologies. Only one ideology lines up with the Word of God.

Another strong theme was that Christian engagement requires political engagement. The gathering began with a question: "Over what part of your life is Jesus not the Lord?" And from there we explored the meaning of voting like a disciple.

The pastors were of one belief that the current systems and processes of our government are not working the way they should. Yet this does not mean we abandon political involvement. It means we transform it with the Gospel.

In my remarks, I reminded the pastors that the insanity of our times has its roots in abortion. "Today we can't say a man is a man or a woman is a woman," I told them. "Maybe that's because for 50 years we've been saying a baby's not a baby."

I urged the pastors to join the national prayer campaign for our elections at [ElectionPrayer.com](https://www.electionprayer.com) and we said the Election Prayer together.

We can have no time or patience for small thinking that focuses on whether we like a candidate's "personality" or language. This is a war for survival, and we need the generals who know how to fight and win.

Pro-life movement must work to save our constitutional freedoms

Recently I attended Turning Point USA's Believers' Summit in West Palm Beach, FL. Turning Point is the largest youth political movement in America, and given the implications of Elections 2024 for the pro-life movement, it is one of our movement's best friends.

I was there to represent Priests for Life and several other pro-life groups were in attendance as well.

President Donald J. Trump spoke on the first night, and his key theme was religious freedom. His remarks reminded all of us that if we are to have a pro-life movement at all, we have to preserve the basic freedoms our Constitution guarantees: Freedom of speech, of religion, of the press, of

assembly, and the right to petition the government.

Think of how much the pro-life movement relies on these freedoms to give voice to the unborn, and how the pro-abortion forces and the Democrat Party try to block us on all these fronts. President Trump again mentioned the peaceful pro-life people who are in prison, and vowed to get them out and back home with their families.

He also pointed out the extremism of the Democrats' abortion-on-demand policy. It's a reminder to us that among the greatest things President Trump can do for us in a second term is simply to keep these baby-killing radicals out of the White House and the federal agencies.

A frequent topic of conversation at the summit, especially because it was held in Florida, was the radical pro-abortion Amendment 4, which would impose a fake right to abortion in the state's Constitution. This battle rages in Florida, as in Arizona, Colorado, Maryland, Missouri, Montana, Nebraska, Nevada, New York, and South Dakota.

A number of the exhibitors and individual pro-life activists were handing out helpful literature at the conference about Amendment 4 and the fact that it would take away the parental consent law as well as clinic health and safety requirements that currently protect women in Florida.

The pro-life movement has many allies in the conservative political world. Turning Point USA and the Believers' Summit made it clear that the time for collaboration and action is now more than ever. We have one month to save America from the worst abortion extremism it has ever seen. Indeed, it would not be an exaggeration to say that this is an election to save the pro-life movement and America itself. Let's double down on our efforts to do so.

More than 60,000 Catholics gathered in Indianapolis recently to celebrate the gift Jesus gave us, the Blessed Eucharist. I was so blessed to be among them.

The events at the Tenth National Eucharistic Conference 2024 poured out hope and love for a culture sorely in need of both and available to all believers who approached the Lord with a pure heart in a state of grace.

In his homily at the closing Mass, Cardinal Luis Antonio Tagle of the Philippines - the special envoy of Pope Francis - expressed the hope that the Indianapolis event would lead to a "conversion through the Eucharist."

A key aspect of that conversion, of course, is the rejection of abortion and the protection of the unborn. Priests for Life has been educating the faithful about this at **EucharistAndProLife.org**.

Priests for Life International Work

Priests for Life International is in the midst of a busy fall promoting and defending the unborn at various intergovernmental fora. On September 10 we participated in the Geneva Consensus Declaration's 4th Commemoration, a prolife/family global coalition which stands 37 countries strong. (President Trump got us into the coalition, but Biden took us out.) The event was co-hosted by Uganda and Hungary and attended by over 100 diplomats, senators, members of Congress and non-governmental organizations.

On September 22-23 we took part in the UN's Summit of the Future in NYC. The Summit brought together world leaders to forge a new international consensus on how to deliver a better present and safeguard the future.

We are also preparing, in collaboration with our Parliamentary Network for Critical Issues partner, statements for the UN's 2025 General Assembly Session's Commission on the Status of Women (CSW69) taking place March 10-21. This will be the thirtieth anniversary of the Fourth World Conference on Women and adoption of the Beijing Declaration and Platform for Action (1995). We are likewise preparing statements for the Commission on Social Development (CSocD63) and the Commission on Population Development (CPD58) (meeting dates for both commissions TBD).

childhood mistreatment and pregnancy losses, particularly abortion.

Janet, who is also the co-founder of the Silent No More Awareness Campaign, is a certified Hope Alive counselor and a member of the board. Priests for Life has worked closely with Hope Alive for more than three decades, particularly in the development and 2015 launch of Silent No More's Shockwaves of Abortion initiative, which focused attention on the wider circle of victims impacted by every abortion.

"It was very energizing to be with counselors from all over the world," Janet said. "I have been a personal friend of the Neys for decades and it was wonderful to be with them again as we continue this vital work together."

Priests for Life hosted the international conference in 2018 at its office in Titusville, Florida.

the perfect trifecta - the White House, the Senate, the House of Representatives.

If Trump is elected, he will re-establish the protections of his enhanced Mexico City policy, which protected U.S. taxpayers from funding abortions overseas; end the Veterans Administration's side hustle in abortion, and pardon the peaceful pro-lifers serving lengthy sentences in federal prison, among many other pro-life actions.

And while a Republican-majority Senate and House might not pass a personhood amendment or a law protecting babies at a given gestational age, at least the drastic Women's Health Protection Act won't be a threat anymore. State laws protecting babies and mothers would continue to be enforced.

So the road ahead is very clear. We need to stand by the party willing to offer some protections to the unborn and we need to get those people elected. Once in office, we can push and prod and lobby and insist and complain as loudly as we need to be heard.

The election is upon us. Certainly we can wait that long to take the Republicans to task for what we see as their shortcomings.

The future of our nation relies on that patience.
