Your Organizations and Churches Can Promote Voter Registration

At our February pro-life leadership coalition meeting held at our Florida headquarters, the various C-3 groups in attendance agreed to do everything they can to encourage voter registration and early voting.

C-3 groups, which include churches, can legally do this. You do not have to be a "political" organization.

By the time this publication reaches you, primaries will already have taken place in Arkansas, North Carolina, Texas, Mississippi, and Illinois, with more beginning in May and continuing throughout the summer and fall. Most states also provide opportunities to vote early.

We urge you to vote early if you are able.

Below is sample wording that can be used to encourage voter registration and early voting.

Generic Announcement About Registering and Voting

Ensuring that you and others are prepared for the 2026 elections now underway is more important than ever. Go to CheckYourVoterRegistration.com to verify your voter registration status—whether you are already registered or need to update your details. Vote early if possible. Voting early means you will not need to worry about unexpected situations on Election Day that could prevent you from casting your ballot. To find primary dates and other pertinent information, visit StateElectionCalendar.org.

Aside from this generic message, you may want to send a more specific message to people on your email list who live in particular states as early voting begins there.

Pro-life, pro-abortion amendments on 2026 ballots

Voters in at least three states will find constitutional amendments on abortion when they go to the polls this year. Two would impose a right to abortion in state constitutions; the third would replace a pro-abortion amendment.

In Missouri, a pro-life amendment, if approved, would repeal a pro-abortion one passed in 2024. This year, Missouri Amendment 3, Prohibit Abortion and Gender Transition Procedures for Minors Amendment, needs a "YES" vote. Wording for Early Voting in Primaries *(Some text will vary depending on the state)*

Subject Line: Early Voting Has Begun in [State]

Dear _____,

Early voting has begun in [State] for the [Date] primary election. The last day of early voting is [Date].

The Board of Elections website for [State] is [Web Address], in case you need more information, such as the address of your voting location or a sample ballot. Your early voting location may be different from where you would vote on Election Day.

Go today to CheckYourVoterRegistration.com to verify your voter registration status.

I urge you to vote today or as soon as possible. Do not wait until the last opportunity ([Election Day date]).

In a physical race, we would not let our opponent start running while we stand there and say we will catch up later.

But that is what happens in elections when the other side starts voting now and we say we will wait until [Election Day date].

The sooner you vote—and the sooner others vote—the less likely it is that unexpected circumstances will interfere with your vote. You do not need to be concerned about adverse weather, illness, car trouble, a sick child, or other unexpected issues on Election Day that could prevent you from voting.

When you vote early, your vote is on record, and it becomes harder for a stranger to try to vote in your name. Although this varies from state to state, there are ways to track your ballot from the time you cast it until the results are finalized on Election Night.

If you vote early, the party and campaigns know you have voted, and they can save the time and effort otherwise spent reminding you to vote—freeing resources to reach those who have not yet voted or are less motivated to do so.

In Nevada, a pro-abortion amendment passed in 2024 but has to be approved by voters a second time. Vote NO on Nevada Question 6: Right to Abortion Initiative. Find more information on ending abortion in Nevada at EndAbortionNevada.us.

In Virginia, voters will vote on the falsely-named Right to Reproductive Freedom Amendment, which takes freedom away from both the unborn and the people and their elected representatives. The pro-life vote is a "NO" vote. Find more information on ending abortion in Virginia at EndAbortionVirginia.us.

Two other states also might have ballot amendments, one pro-abortion and one pro-life.

In Idaho, if the Reproductive Freedom and Privacy Act Initiative makes it to the ballot, Vote NO in 2026. Find more information on fighting abortion in Idaho at EndAbortionIdaho.us.

In Nebraska, the Establish Personhood of Preborn Children Amendment should get a resounding YES. Find more information on fighting abortion in Nebraska at EndAbortionNebraska.us.

Healing Breaks Deadly Cycle of Repeat Abortions

April is Abortion Recovery Awareness Month and we are proud and humbled to say no ministry has helped more mothers and fathers heal from abortion than Rachel's Vineyard, an organization that operates under the Priests for Life umbrella.

The women and men who attend these retreats are always surprised there are so many others who experience prolonged grief and trauma after abortion. Resonating strongly with one another's stories, they realize they are no longer alone in their distress.

This helps to lift the stigma and shame in a world where suffering after abortion is ignored and minimized. Those in supportive healing groups learn it's possible to survive and find meaning in all the unspoken suffering.

Grief and heartache that's honored can move us toward a deeper empathy for the suffering of others. Especially when we have experienced the redemption of our own terrors, we are better equipped to journey with others through unspeakable loss—to help bear their burden or sorrow, to help another rise up.

Hundreds of life-giving ministries have been started by people who have been healed from their abortions.

But the impact does not stop there. When a person is healed from the traumatic experience of abortion, they bring that healing back into their families and their marriages. They become more present to their children. There is a ripple effect for the entire family, the community, and the world.

Once they have discovered the peace that ends their internal war, many women desire to give voice to their own experience (see SilentNoMore.com). They feel they were misled, lied to, deceived, pressured and exploited during their pregnancy. They believe

A Kingdom Conquered

"Dux vitae mortuus, regnat vivus"--"Life's Captain, who died, now lives and reigns."

These words come from the ancient Easter Sequence, the *Victimae Paschali*, which is proclaimed before the Gospel on Easter Sunday Masses. The message is clear: Easter is not simply about someone rising from the dead; it is about the conquering of a Kingdom. Life's Captain not only lives; He also reigns. He has a kingdom, and it is the Kingdom of Life. Jesus is explicit about this when speaking to the apostles after His Resurrection. *"All power in heaven and on earth has been given to me"* (Mt. 28:18).

Death is not merely a single event. It, too, is a kingdom, to which some choose to belong. *"By the envy of the devil, death entered the world, and they who are in his possession experience it"* (Wisdom 2:24). Yet God *"has rescued us from the power of darkness and transferred us to the kingdom of his beloved Son"* (Col. 1:13; see also Heb. 2:14-15). Christ, by rising, has not only overcome His own death; He has overcome ours! He has overturned the entire kingdom of death.

The effects of that defeated kingdom do, indeed, endure, even as the Kingdom of God makes progress in growth through the phases of human history. Pope John Paul II pointed out the existence of *"a kind of 'conspiracy against life,'"* a *"war of the powerful against the weak"* in our day (see *The Gospel of Life (EV)*, n.12).

Yet in working to overcome this culture of death, marked most tragically by abortion, we are not simply working *"for victory."* We, rather, are working *"from victory!"* Victory is our starting point. Christ is Risen! This concrete, historical event, in all its truth and significance, contains the objective defeat of the culture of death. The Victory of Life, furthermore, is present in every Mass, where we proclaim, *"Dying you destroyed our death; Rising you restored our life!"*

Easter gives us our identity as *"the people of life"* (EV n.79). Baptized into Christ's victory over death, we are also sent to proclaim, celebrate, and serve that victory (see EV 78-101). At Easter Mass, we renew the vows of our baptism, one of which is that we *"reject Satan and all his works."* Chief among those works is death. Yet the Son of God has destroyed death, and that means that we who follow Him likewise are called to stand against it.

Many who sincerely believe may not realize the full implications of that belief. To believe in and celebrate the Resurrection necessarily immerses us in and commits us to the conflict against evils such as abortion and euthanasia. We are not free to ignore the battle or entrust it to someone else. It belongs to our very identity to fight it. It belongs to the very identity of the priest, furthermore, to preach it.

And it belongs to our identity to do all this with the utmost serenity, confidence, and joy. Christ is truly Risen and is with us! Let us rejoice and be glad!

"Ours is not an option to wait for someone else"

Father Denis Wilde, OSA, full-time pastoral associate of Priests for Life, has been involved in the pro-life movement since before Roe v. Wade legalized abortion in 1973.

In the 1980s, he personally witnessed to the "rescue" movement and developed ties with pro-lifers from other Christian denominations that he has maintained and expanded throughout out his more than 50 years in the movement.

A native of Long Island, N.Y., Father Denis is an Augustinian priest and a member of the Province of St. Thomas of Villanova in Pennsylvania. He is unique in the pro-life movement in that he is also a concert pianist, and when he gives talks at parishes, he often also performs in concert!

He holds a Ph.D. in music from Catholic University of America and was an associate professor of music and choral director at Villanova University for many years before coming to Priests for Life in 1998.

Father Denis has performed in concert all over the country and has been a guest conductor on five continents. He loves to travel and the Priests for Life staff looks forward to seeing his photos and hearing his commentary on his many overseas trips.

His heart for the unborn remains broken, and so he continues his pro-life ministry, attending marches, speaking at parishes and taking part in annual Face the Truth tours. He has accumulated many accolades over the years and was particularly proud in 2021 to receive the Pro-Life Achievement Award from the Pennsylvania Pro-Life Federation.



"There is, sadly, no more dangerous place to live than the womb," Father Denis said of his decision to devote his ministry to the protection of the unborn. "This bizarre situation of a culture of death propped up by law and camouflaged as medicine perpetuates a lie of a colossal order. Its consequence is a dead end street to baby, mother and civilization."

Father Denis is outspoken about the need for the clergy to become actively involved in the protection of life from the womb to the tomb.

"A priest needs to be at the front, side by side and supporting his flock in this battle for life," he said. "Ours is not an option to wait for someone else to come along. What a joy it is to know that God is in charge and will not fail to lead us forward to end this 'unspeakable crime.'"

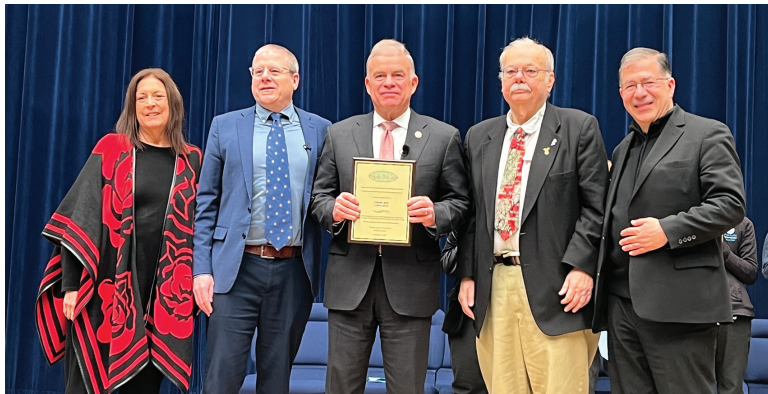

women deserve better than abortion.

Men also participate in public testimony and share their regret (see TearsOfTheFisherman.org). Other fathers are deeply troubled that men have no rights to protect the lives of their unborn children. The significant "voice of experience" in the ongoing public debate provides important perspectives. For some, their empowering sense of grief resolution becomes the impetus for political engagement.

But when we deny the pain—and sometimes horror—of what it means to suffer the loss of a child in an abortion, we can also deny what actually happened. Instead of healing, our hearts harden, and we can negate what we need in order to feel safe and loved. Over time, this denial can have serious negative consequences.

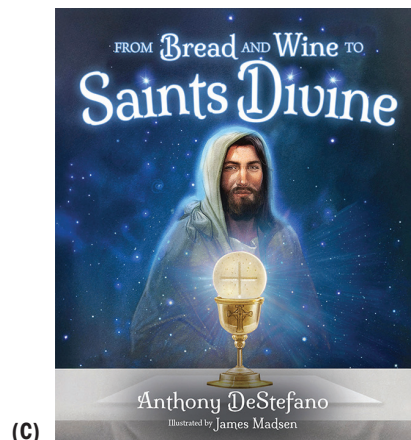
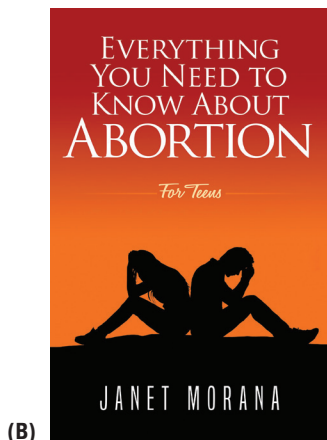
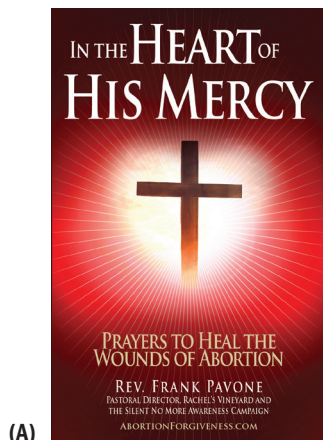
