passionately pro-life these Golden State residents are. They wear their faith on their sleeves, to borrow an old saying.

Much credit goes to conference organizer Barbara Vollick for arranging for high-caliber speakers and exhibitors.

In my remarks to the conference, I pointed out the deep connections between our love for the unborn and the devotion to Divine Mercy - a devotion very common among Catholic pro-life activists. St. Faustina, to whom the Chaplet of Divine Mercy was revealed, was told that while we are to ask God's mercy for all the sins of the world, that it was the sin of abortion in particular that God was imploring people to pray about.

St. Faustina, as her Diary relates, was also allowed to feel the pains of women having abortions, as a reminder of how much this grieves the heart of God.

I then connected all of this with the need to invoke God's mercy on our nation at this moment when tyranny has raised its ugly head. I pointed out how the fascist chant, "Viva la muerte!" ("Long live death!") characterizes what the Left does, both in abortion and in the destruction of the family, values, freedom, and America itself. It's all connected. The violent protests we see are never about the issue (whether it's "Palestine" or George Floyd or anything else), but simply about the desire to divide and destabilize society. It's American Marxism.

Conference attendees - which included a large number of teenage boys and young men - were well-versed in the importance of this year's election, and among the items that were most popular on the Priests for Life table were our election prayer card and a comparison of the Democrat and Republican party platforms.

Pedro Diaz-Rubin, a friend from long ago, was an exhibitor for his "Apostolate of the Unborn Jesus," which promotes awareness of the Incarnation of Jesus. He urges people to learn how to worship Jesus as an unborn baby in Mary's womb and to make that connection between faith and working to protect the unborn.

May the Divine Mercy indeed save our nation in this crucial election year, and bring victory to the pro-life movement!

## **How Democrats' push of abortion can backfire**

Democrat-supporting political operations have been planning to pour hundreds of millions of dollars into pushing "abortion rights" in this year's election.

As I've been saying, it's quite a sad commentary on a political party when the message and strategy that they put the most confidence in is to kill more babies.

But as someone who has been working to fight abortion fulltime in the national political arena for over thirty years, I have my doubts about how well this desperate Democrat strategy will work.

First of all, most voters simply do not have "abortion rights" at the top of their priority list. Sure, the reversal of Roe has angered the abortion-loving Democrats, and anger is a strong motivator in elections. That's why we see more "abortion rights" voters naming abortion as an important issue than anti-abortion voters this year (see, for instance, the recent Priests for Life/McLaughlin poll

at [www.AbortionSurvey.org](http://www.AbortionSurvey.org)).

But does it do the trick, namely, provide a sufficient distraction for voters from the failed and destructive policies of the Democrats?

I don't think so.

First of all, they can in fact get an abortion. Abortion has not gone away. There is no national ban, and in most places, there is no state ban either. And the recent Supreme Court ruling keeps chemical abortion on the market.

Another reason, though, that the abortion push won't necessarily work is that "abortion rights" is not, to borrow a phrase from Dan Bongino, a "finger-stick" issue.

"Finger-stick" issues bother the voters over and over again, day after day, week after week: the prices each time they get gas or buy groceries, the filthy conditions and unrest in Democrat-run cities, the migrants camping out in the neighborhood park at the gracious invitation of Joe Biden and company.

The recurring pain gets the voters' attention, and after a while, many of them will say it's time to make a change.

But "abortion rights" just don't have that every-day, attention-grabbing, finger-pricking characteristic.

If anything about the abortion issue comes close to that dynamic, it's actually something that favors the anti-abortion side.

In my work, I serve as the Pastoral Director of two worldwide ministries that serve moms and dads who have lost children to abortion: Rachel's Vineyard and the Silent No More Awareness Campaign. These efforts help people who are wounded, psychologically, spiritually, and physically by abortion,

to find the healing they seek and deserve.

And one of the things we learn from them is that they never forget their abortion. The "choice" (more accurately, the act of desperation) they thought would solve a problem has instead brought a whole host of new problems, among which are intrusive thoughts about the aborted child, nightmares, and triggered emotional reactions when they see a baby carriage, or hear the sound of a vacuum that reminds them of the abortion suction machine, or hear something about abortion in the news.

These reactions are real, frequent, and oppressive.

Indeed, so many who have had abortions experience these things so regularly that we might call them "finger-prick" issues.

When these people hear politicians and political action committees howling for more "abortion rights," they feel a deep pain and resentment, and are acutely aware of how disconnected and clueless these activists are to the real pain, grief and devastation experienced by those who have bought the product that the activists so eagerly market.

And they are angry, furthermore, that the marketers never tell the truth.

How much of the \$100 million to be spent pushing "abortion rights" will produce videos that actually show an abortion. If someone is convinced abortion is so good, why hide what you are pushing?

How much of the "women's rights" rhetoric, moreover, will warn about a single negative effect of abortion, or give voice to a single woman who has experienced the pain and grief abortion bring?

The abortion-loving Democrats might want to think twice about bringing abortion front and center. It is a two-edged sword. And every day, sadly, the numbers swell of voters who know all too well that this so-called "right" is a source of daily pain, deep regret, and heart-rending despair.

## From New York to Rome to Jerusalem

Priests for Life's Bob Lalonde from our international department took part again in this year's Holy See Mission to the United Nations' annual Path to Peace Gala in Manhattan. The honoree this year was Frá John Dunlap, Grand Master of the Sovereign Military Order of Malta.

The event brought together more than 400 supporters of the Mission. Priests for Life has been supporting the Holy See Mission for decades, from the time that Cardinal Renato Martino (then Archbishop) was St. John Paul II's representative, at the UN. We are privileged to work side by side with the Mission for the defense of the unborn at the United Nations.

Bob spent Memorial Day weekend in Rome to take part in the Vatican's first ever World Children's Day, attended by more than 50,000 children (born and unborn) and adults from around the world.

Our activity in Rome serves to remind various Vatican agencies of the urgent need to keep the

plight of the unborn at the top of the priority list, and not to let the abortion issue be obscured by things like "climate change."

Bob also flew to Jerusalem to tour Efrat, an organization founded in 1977 that offers mothers in difficult circumstances a full safety net of support to enable them to choose life for their babies.

Executive Director Nir Salomon is a friend of Priests for Life who has visited our headquarters for our meeting with national pro-life leaders. Nir arranged for Ruth Tidhar, the director of the assistance department, to give Bob a tour of the office and adjacent warehouse, where all the goods are pre-packaged and sent out to individual homes for delivery. The organization has saved more than 85,000 babies through its compassionate services.

Unlike most developed nations, including the U.S., Israel has been boosting its birth rate. A population needs a 2.1 birth rate per woman to sustain itself. The average in Europe and the U.S. is 1.6. Israel boasts a birth rate of 3.1.

"Efrat focuses on helping women during their pregnancies and for two whole years after," Bob said. "I suggest that Efrat has played a key role in achieving these milestone results."

Now it's the first question on just about everyone's mind. And the more awareness there is, the more likely we are to be able to prevent it.

Second, an unprecedented number of election integrity measures have been enacted all across the country, strengthening voter ID, cleaning up voter rolls, protecting poll watchers so that they can do their jobs, and strengthening the chain of custody for ballots, among other measures.

And third, numerous lawsuits have been won to enforce existing election integrity laws, such as making sure that election workers actually verify that signatures on the ballots match signatures in the voter files, rather than just presuming that they do.

Moreover, our side, through the efforts of the new leadership at the RNC (Lara Trump and Mike Whatley) and of many other organizations, is gearing up for a massive presence at polling places of poll worker, poll watchers, and attorneys who will all be ready to prevent fraud as much as possible.

The key, in the end, is to overwhelm the other side with the number of votes cast on our side. Vote early. Bring others out to vote. There is a margin of fraud, beyond which the other side simply cannot steal enough votes to win. As President Trump says, we need to make it "Too Big to Rig."

One way we can do this is to ensure that every pro-life American who qualifies is registered to vote, and registered properly. The numbers of unregistered pro-lifers, and unregistered Christians, is terrifying. We need to get each and every one of those people registered, and to the polls on Election Day (or earlier, depending on the state).

Registration deadlines vary from state to state so make sure you know what your state requires. At [StateElectionCalendar.org](http://StateElectionCalendar.org), you can find registration deadlines and state-by-state rules on early voting. You can check your voter registration, and find out how to register, at [CheckYourVoterRegistration.com](http://CheckYourVoterRegistration.com).

We also invite you to be part of our election volunteers. We have a dedicated team of pro-lifers willing to help in any way they can to ensure that this election is free and fair - and decided on the side of life.
