
Rallies and Prayers at the Supreme Court

With the Supreme Court starting its new session on the first Monday of October, pro-life leaders and activists held events at the Court over the weekend of October 2. Father Frank and Youth Outreach Director Bryan Kemper were there to pray for the Justices and the *Dobbs* case out of Mississippi that could dismantle *Roe v. Wade*.

On Saturday morning Father Frank and Bryan started the day praying at Planned Parenthood before heading over to the Court to help lead an afternoon prayer rally. During the rally, the pro-abortion activists finished their march for abortion and passed right in front of the pro-lifers.

On Sunday morning Father Frank led a pro-life rosary in front of the Court which was followed by an interdenominational service he helped lead with Rev. Pat Mahoney. That night, there was a very moving candlelight prayer vigil in front of the Court.

Then, the next morning, Fr. Frank and Priests for Life helped to lead another rally in front of the Court, during which two large scrolls were unrolled on the sidewalk, bearing the words of "The Moral Outcry" that was signed by half a million citizens, calling abortion a crime against humanity and presenting the reasons why the Court should reverse *Roe v. TX and MS Lawmakers to be honored at 2022 National Prayer Service

Heroes of the Heartbeat movement will be honored at the 2022 National Prayer Service hosted by Priests for Life and the National Pro-Life Religious Council.

The annual interdenominational service, held on the morning of the March for Life - Jan. 21 - will present Pro-Life Achievement Awards to Janet Porter, who originated the heartbeat bill; to Texas lawmakers and attorneys instrumental in passing the Heartbeat Law in the Lone Star State, and Mississippi lawmakers responsible for that state's Gestational Age Act, which the Supreme Court is now reviewing in a case that could lead to the repeal of legal of abortion in this nation.

"It is a joy to know these courageous men and women," said Fr. Frank Pavone, "and we want to give an opportunity for pro-life activists nationwide to thank them in person."

Music, prayers and preaching also will be part of the service that will take place from 8:30 to 10:30 a.m. in DAR Constitution Hall, 1776 D Street NW in Washington, D.C.

Large groups can easily be accommodated in the landmarked hall, where many historic gatherings occur. While tickets are not required for the free prayer service, we do ask those who expect to attend to register at NationalPrayerService.com

This year we have seen the Democrat-dominated House try to ram its extreme abortion agenda down the throats, and into the pocketbooks, of all Americans. Two pro-life warriors gone too soon

Two great pro-life warriors who worked closely with us at Priests for Life have gone home to the Lord. They are Nancy Tanner Givans, a regional coordinator for the Silent No More Awareness Campaign, and Eugene Vigil, our staff member who served as executive assistant to Alveda King.

Nancy died on January 9, 2021, after a fearless battle with cancer. Fearlessness was Nancy's trademark in her fight for the unborn. As a Silent No More regional coordinator for northern Virginia, Nancy used her proximity to the nation's capital to great advantage. Holding a sign that read "I Regret My Abortion," Nancy could be found standing outside the office buildings of the U.S. Senate and House of Representatives, presenting an inconvenient truth to pro-abortion lawmakers, often as they were headed in to vote on legislation about abortion.

Nancy and her sign also were regulars outside NARAL Pro-Choice America's annual "celebration" of the *Roe v. Wade* anniversary. She was interviewed on numerous news outlets, including EWTN and the BBC. She shared her testimony all over the country about how she regretted her abortion.

She is survived by her husband, Charlie Givans, four daughters and eight grandchildren.

Eugene Vigil came to work for Priests for Life in 2010. Working from a home office in Georgia, as assistant to our fulltime Pastoral Associate Alveda King, Eugene never minded working long hours. His co-workers remember him as a gentle man with a great sense of humor and a ready smile. He was a faithful Catholic who was completely committed to ending abortion.

Eugene and his late wife took in foster children, once opening their home to four siblings and three other children at the same time. Eugene remembered that time as one of the most fun experiences of his life. They adopted two children, Alicia and Isaiah, and leave behind two grandchildren.

"All who knew Eugene saw a man of deep faith, who understood that faith leads to action. He took that action in the pro-life arena and we were blessed to have him do so as part of the Priests for Life team," said Father Frank Pavone.


