New course at online Pro-Life University centers on the Eucharist

In the midst of the March for Life activities in Washington, D.C., in January, Priests for Life announced the launch of Pro-Life University, an online program National Director Frank Pavone is spearheading with Bishop Joseph Strickland, Deacon Keith Fournier and Catholic Online.

The free program will offer classes in every aspect of the pro-life movement: Science, medicine, law, religion, public relations, politics, and the process of healing the wounds that follow abortion.

In late April, we announced the release of a new class called "Pro-Life Commitment is Eucharistic." The class is geared toward renewing Catholics' devotion to the Eucharist, as the Church in America focuses on that theme.

The goal in establishing such a learning program is to equip God's people to abolish abortion. As the bishop said, we need to "eliminate abortion from our vocabulary and from the human experience."

Rachel's Vineyard Update

Dr. Theresa Burke, founder of Rachel's Vineyard and Pastoral Associate of Priests for Life, was in Tulsa, OK the week of April 15 to train Rachel's Vineyard and Grief to Grace team members, retreat facilitators, and volunteers. She used several facilitation modules to teach somatic interventions when encountering participants on a retreat weekend. These techniques help facilitators deal with the triggers and trauma retreatants experience as they look to become restored on a retreat.

On April 25, Dr. Burke was in New Orleans, LA as a plenary speaker for the Catholic Psychotherapist Conference (CPA). Her 2-part series, included a lecture and a practicum, and was titled, *The Living Scripture Method: Therapy for the Soul*.

To honor Monsignor Michael Mannion for his 50 years of work at the Discovery House in New Jersey, Dr. Burke spoke at the Union League in Philadelphia on Thursday, May 2.

The week of May 20th Dr. Burke travelled to Minnesota to work with the Grief to Grace and Rachel's Vineyard teams using Living Scripture in an afternoon respite retreat. She then gave a training to staff and volunteers from 40 pregnancies that are supported through the Elevate Life organization.

Rachel's Vineyard held a total of 29 retreats in May.

In April, Rvdo. P. Orlando Lugo Perez, JCD, from Ponce, Puerto Rico, attended the retreat with the Palm Beach Spanish team. He was so moved by both the retreat and RV team, he is seeking approval from the Diocese of Ponce to bring Rachel's Vineyard retreats to the area some time in 2025.

Thousands of Pro-Life People Join California March for Life to Protest Abortion

The fourth annual March for Life California, held in Sacramento in April, marked a homecoming of sorts for both me and Priests for Life, where I serve as the coordinator of street activism and youth outreach director.

I'm a native of Southern California and Priests for Life was founded in San Francisco in 1991. When a young priest named Father Frank Pavone took the reins of the organization in 1993, its base of operations moved to New York. Since 2017, Priests for Life has been headquartered on Central Florida's Space Coast. I live in Ohio now.

But our ministry has always been built around traveling to wherever we need to go to get the pro-life message heard, so I made the trip here to march in solidarity with activists living in a state that seems to prefer its citizens dead rather than alive.

Here representing the Silent No More Awareness Campaign was Carol Marie Siedenber, the campaign's regional coordinator for San Diego, some 600 miles south. Four other pro-lifers made the long trip with her, and other supporters of Silent No More, a project of Priests for Life and Anglicans for Life, carried signs that read "Women Do Regret Abortion," and "Men Regret Lost Fatherhood."

"I wanted to be here because I felt I'm part of the problem. I created the problem by being post-abortive and I want to be part of the solution," Ms. Siedenbug said. "My being here gave me the opportunity to be interviewed by Channel 13 (CBS) here in Sacramento and I pray to God that the Holy Spirit worked through my voice and will reach out and touch the hearts of some who hear the interview."

My trip here started with an invitation to the Defend Life dinner Sunday night, and I was thrilled and honored that some young activists from organizations like Live Action and Pro-Life San Francisco were picking my brain and treating me like an elder of the movement - which, after more than 30 years, I am!

Pregnancy help centers were honored at the banquet, and today at the march, red heart-shaped balloons emblazoned with the words "Love Them Both" - a motto of the help movement - could be spotted throughout the crowd of thousands, and many speakers at the rally talked about the importance of these centers that offer far more support to families than just diapers and bottles.

Before the march I helped lead a "die-in" organized by the California-based Survivors of the Abortion Holocaust. Thousands watched, enthralled, as young people fell on the ground and draped red blankets over themselves, each representing a baby killed by abortion today.

A band named California Will be Saved led a worship service right in front of the Capitol building. This was the same band that led worship in the middle of Beverly Hills last year during an action that was so successful, the owners of a planned abortion mill were told they were no longer welcome.

Gov. Gavin Newsom never showed his face but that's no surprise, as he is one of the most abortion-friendly governors in the nation. He was in the news that day for proposing an emergency bill that would allow Arizona abortionists - who soon could find themselves out of work - to perform abortions in the Golden State, and he released a hideously untrue commercial targeting an Alabama law that makes it illegal for people to help minor girls leave the state for abortions.

California pro-lifers have their work cut out for them but they are up to the challenge. That same week, the bill SB 1368, came up for discussion that would require the state Education Department to make information about pregnancy centers available on its internet website and included in resources disseminated by school districts.

The fact is that abortion destroys the women who commit it.

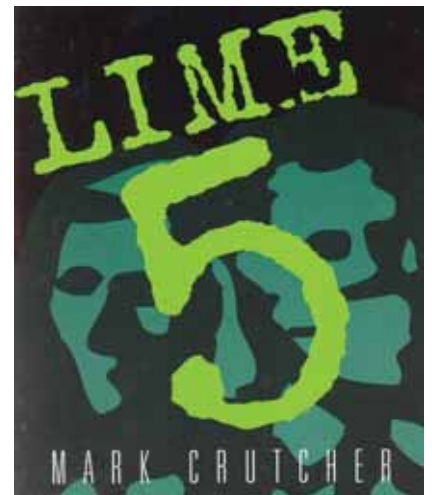
Not only does it destroy them because of the spiritual, physical, and psychological damage it does.

But many also think that, morality aside, "legal" means "safe." They therefore reason that although abortion is wrong, at least it should be legal for the sake of the lives, health, and safety of women.

Read *Lime 5*, and you will see documented evidence that "legal" does not mean "safe," especially when it comes to abortion. You will see how the abortion industry does not at all serve the health and safety of women.

You will be shocked, disgusted, and outraged.

And you will have in your hands a tool to challenge supporters of legal abortion, who clamor for the rights and health and safety of women.

And this evidence continues to be compiled to this day. You can see it, for instance, in further publications that back up the findings in *Lime 5*, such as the publication "Unsafe," by Americans United for Life (See AUL.org/Unsafe).

The challenge, which I repeat today with a call to all people everywhere, is this: *Are those who work so hard to keep abortion legal and available for the sake of the "health and safety of women" willing to work just as hard to see to it that abortion is in fact safe for those same women? Are they willing to examine the evidence that the abortion industry does not protect the health and safety of women, and that the most common surgical procedure in America is also the least regulated? Are they willing to speak out about the abuses documented in studies like Lime 5? If not, why not?*

Where, indeed, is the allegiance of those who clamor for the availability of abortion? Is it with the women they claim to care about, or for the abortion industry and those who run it?

This book lays out the challenge, and lays out concrete legislative proposals for the protection of the women of our land.

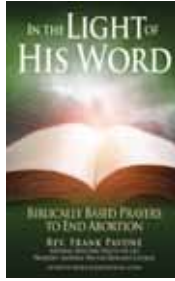
