Priests for Life never slows down, not even during the summertime. July through September were jam packed with events and conferences.

There's a reason for that: the recent Supreme Court victory *does not reduce our work; it simply makes it more effective.* What the Court did was to *take away restrictions on the pro-life movement's ability to protect the unborn* - it did not automatically restore that protection!

It's still up to us to do that by getting pro-life laws passed. But to do that, we

have to elect pro-life lawmakers, and to do that we have to persuade the public that the unborn need to be protected from abortion.

So our work remains! And we are doing it vigorously. As a result, my team and I have been on the road quite a bit.

The month of July started out with the Divine Mercy in Temecula, CA, where I was a featured speaker along with Fr. Donald Calloway, MIC, and Tim Staples of Catholic Answers.

Fr. Calloway kindly wrote,

Successfully activating and encouraging elections volunteers ahead of these critical midterms

The political outreach department has been very busy activating volunteers in their communities as the elections become more front and center.

We have volunteers working on governors' races, U.S. House and Senate races not only in their hometowns but in other states, and many local races. These volunteers have been in touch with Priests for Life for encouragement, best practices, advice, and getting their questions answered. We hosted elections meetings every week in September, with guest speakers from the American First Policy Institute, Leadership Institute, and iVoterGuide, among other organizations.

Along with our "Party Comparison Piece" (See VotingInfo.net), which quotes from the platforms of the Republican and Democrat Parties on various issues, we have added this year a comparison piece that shows in practice what each party has done for America: Patriotic education vs. Critical Race Theory; secure borders vs. open borders; law and order vs. defunding the police; strong economy vs. inflation, and so forth. You can find this new piece at **ProLifeVote.com**.

Our election training meetings this month are Thursday, Oct. 6; Wednesday, Oct. 12; Thursday, Oct. 20; and Wednesday, Oct. 26. Our November meeting will be on Thursday, Nov. 3. From Florida's Space Coast, all the pro-life news you need

When Communications Director Leslie Palma moved to Florida, after working off-location for 12 years, it made more sense than ever to use our state-of-the-art television studio to produce a news show. Leslie came to Priests for Life after a 30-year career as a newspaper reporter and editor and describes herself still as a "news junkie."

But she was reluctant - to put it mildly - to get in front of the camera.

Executive Manager Theresa Watson, on the other hand, was a natural on the set of Just Ask Janet, Praying for America with Father Frank and our other shows. They teamed up with our social media manager Rob Collins and got started developing plans for ProLife PrimeTime News.

Rob created a set featuring a breathtaking photo of a rocket launch, which helps highlight our ministry's location on Florida's Space Coast. He put together an exciting lead-in to the show and every week incorporates videos and graphics that help bring the stories to life.

The show was scheduled to launch June 24, which turned out to be an auspicious day, as Roe v. Wade was overturned that morning. The inaugural show was able to incorporate the live broadcasts that Father Frank, Janet Morana and Bryan Kemper did that morning.

Other Priests for Life staffers are involved in the show as well. Studio intern John Thomas helped with videos during his summer in the office. Travel coordinator Michael Moll has begun doing the "Priests for Life on the Road" segment and Anthony Visone from the Resource Department stepped into the co-anchor chair when Leslie was ill.

ProLife PrimeTime News airs every Friday at 9 p.m. ET at **EndAbortion.TV** and all the social media platforms linked from there. Also, our friends at Right Side Broadcasting Network air the show on their YouTube channel most Fridays.

Plans in the works for Priests for Life participation in 2023 March for Life

Roe v. Wade is history but the March for Life will go on, because abortion is not yet ended. Priests for Life will continue to be an integral part of the national pro-life event in Washington, D.C., which will take place on Friday, Jan. 20, 2023.

We again will organize a peaceful protest and prayer rally in front of Planned Parenthood from 9 to 11 a.m. on Thursday, Jan. 19. D.C.'s flagship killing center is located at 1225 4th St. NE.

The 28th annual National Prayer Service will take place from 8:30 to 10:30 a.m. on Friday, the day of the March, at Constitution Hall, 1776 D. St. NW. The National Pro-Life Religious Council, Priests for Life and the National Right to Life Committee annually sponsor the interdenominational event that brings together dozens of clergy and pro-life leaders to pray for an end to abortion and to present the Pro-Life Recognition Award.

NationalPrayerService.com will have more information as the event gets closer.

Women and men of the Silent No More Awareness Campaign will take part in the March and will give their testimonies of abortion regret, as they have since 2003.

Also, on Sunday, Jan. 22, Silent No More will again join with the Christian Defense Coalition, the Purple Sash Revolution and Faith & Liberty in the Nation's Capital for prayer and testimony in front of the U.S. Supreme Court building. The service, inaugurated last year, is a memorial to the American holocaust, organized on the anniversary of the *Roe v. Wade* decision.

Priests for Life will have a booth at the March for Life expo, as well as at the Students for Life Conference at the Omni Shoreham Hotel and the Cardinal O'Connor Conference at Georgetown University.
