Priests for Life work moves full speed ahead during pandemic

Florida was one of the last states to tell residents to stay indoors but Priests for Life was ready with a plan that went into action as soon as the executive order was released on April 3.

Because of the national scope of our ministry, many of our team members work from their home offices already – in Maryland, Alabama, Texas, Georgia, Pennsylvania, Ohio and other states – so it was pretty much business as usual for them.

Our Florida-based staffers also moved to home offices, connected closely all day by videoconferencing.

The biggest impact on our work was the fact that the non-stop travels of our team to events around the country was put on hold. Pro-life conferences were either canceled, postponed, or held virtually, such as the Heartbeat International Conference, at which Fr. Frank gave a keynote talk on Elections 2020.

Here's a sampling of some of the other things that kept us busy:

- We were in constant contact and collaboration with government leaders about spreading the word about how to keep safe from the virus.
- We continued to register and train moms, dads, siblings, grandparents and others to be part of our Silent No More Campaign.
- Our Rachel's Vineyard team responded to hotline calls for counseling after an abortion.

- We kept in touch with priests and deacons through emails and conference calls. Father Frank Pavone's book, Proclaiming the Message of Life, was mailed out to hundreds of deacons across the country who requested a copy.
- We hosted online events on political responsibility.
- We continued filling orders for our pro-life literature, t-shirts and other resources.
- Our Correspondence Department kept up with questions received by mail, email and phone.
- Our Pastoral Team members continued doing media interviews on television, radio and in print, and getting their opinion pieces published in numerous news outlets.
- We took part in nationwide conferences online.
- We made plans for getting back on the road once our nation reopens for business.
- And perhaps most visibly, we broadcast Mass twice daily, along with the rosary and Divine Mercy Chaplet. Pro-life programming was streamed throughout each day at www.EndAbortion.TV and its related social media and video streaming platforms.


