


Expanded edition of *Christmas for the Unborn* available in paperback

There is a universality about Christmas.

"Behold, I proclaim to you good news of great joy that will be *for all the people*...A Savior has been born *for you*" (Luke 1:10-11).

Christ the Savior becomes man precisely for all who share human nature. He excludes nobody. The good news of Christmas is for all people of all times and places. "Joy to *the world*."

Our whole movement has been excited and encouraged by the Heartbeat Law that began protecting babies Sept. 1 throughout Texas.

The Supreme Court let it go into effect and it's the most protective pro-life law that has been enacted since Roe vs. Wade!

Also the Supreme Court agreed to review Mississippi's law protecting babies starting at 15 weeks, and this case could reverse Roe vs. Wade.

Do you want to say "Thank you" to the people of Texas and Mississippi and their lawmakers?

That's exactly what we are going to do at the National Prayer Service on the morning of the March for Life!

On Friday, January 21, 2022, we will once again hold the National Prayer Service at DAR Constitution Hall in Washington, D.C.

On Thursday, January 20th, from 9 to 11 a.m., we will have a peaceful and prayerful protest outside Planned Parenthood, located at 1225 4th St. NE. Immediately following the March on Friday the 21st, in front of the Supreme Court building, the women and men of the Silent No More Awareness Campaign will talk about their abortions and the emotional and physical devastation they suffered in their wake.

Priests for Life also will have representatives at the Students for Life Conference at the Omni Shoreham Hotel in D.C., and the Cardinal John J. O'Connor Conference at Georgetown University.

Fr. Frank Pavone interviews Bishop Conley, Bishop of the Diocese of Lincoln, NE

Bishop Conley: I think back on Priests for Life, whether it was in Wichita or here in Lincoln or in different places where we've been together, and one of the things I think that I have seen both as a priest and as a bishop as a great value is, helping priests be able to preach and teach the pro-life message, giving us the courage, giving us the tools, the arguments, the information, to be able to, like you yourself do so well, Father Frank, to get up in front of people and speak about a subject that is uncomfortable.

You know it's uncomfortable. Nobody likes to preach about abortion, but to be able to preach about it in a loving and winning way that wins hearts over to the life side. So that's been one of the greatest ... and continues to be because as young priests are coming up through the ranks, and I've found that our younger

generation priests are really ready to step into the battle and to preach and teach the truth of the church. But to give them the tools like Priests Life does, to be able to preach well and compassionately and with eloquence, but also with passion and conviction -- that's really one of the great things that Priests for Life does.

And also ... when I was pro-life director in Wichita I started Project Rachel. So you know, as passionately as we preach against abortion, at the same time we have to preach the mercy for women and for fathers, mothers and fathers who've gone through the abortion experience, and to reach out to the walking wounded and to have that compassion for them...

Because I think one time you said no one really chooses, no woman ever chooses to get an abortion. It's not a "choice." She feels forced into it and she's been pressured into it by those who really should be giving her good advice but who aren't.

And so reaching out to those who have suffered the trauma of an abortion either through Project Rachel or Rachel's Vineyard or Silent No More – all these things that Priests for Life do such a good job, and you can't ever lose that, that's such an important aspect of this whole thing.

So I have great hope, and I hope that the Priests for Life continues to flourish.


