Pastors may be hesitant about preaching on the sensitive topic of abortion around the time of Mother's Day. After 25 years of ministry outreach to women and men hurting after abortion, we can say it's actually the perfect time.

Many of the women we have encountered in our Rachel's Vineyard Ministry (RachelsVineyard.org - 1 877 HOPE 4 ME), have reported that Mother's Day was a time when they experienced various levels of grief, anxiety, and a resurgence of thoughts and memories from their abortion experience.

Julia shares:

Many years ago, Father Frank Pavone came across a story of a graduating class that dedicated its yearbook to all the students who would have been graduating that year had they not been killed by abortion. How fitting a tribute that is. Other graduating classes have paid tribute to their abortion victims by a moment of prayer at the baccalaureate Mass or at the graduation ceremony.

Life is mixed up with happiness and sadness, joy and tragedy. Significant moments in our lives should not be insulated from all awareness of injustice. We need to rejoice with those who rejoice, but we should weep with those who weep (see Romans 12:15).

Nearly a million students will not be graduating this year. They were killed by abortion.

Let's acknowledge those who will be missing from these ceremonies, those who could not celebrate with us, and let's work to let others live. Perhaps an empty chair at the graduation ceremony, in honor of the missing children, or a lit candle, or a short prayer of remembrance. This would be accompanied by a compassionate prayer for the healing of all those who have had abortions or been complicit in them, focusing on the mercy of God.

We can be joyful on this day and celebrate our milestones while also remembering the missing children this year and every year until abortion is abolished in this country.

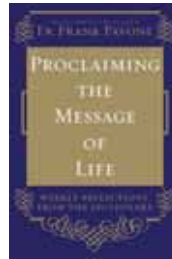
