A look back at elections 2022: Not so bad

The political outreach department at Priests for Life was incredibly busy the last year working with volunteers all over the country and plugging them into election-related volunteer activities based on their locality and interests.

We provided volunteers with opportunities to knock on doors and make phone calls to persuadable voters, and even to help clean up our nation's voter rolls.

Others became poll workers or spoke to their pastors about educating voters in the parish. Our volunteers posted material on social media, helped various campaigns, and worked hard on ballot initiatives.

In addition to Fr. Frank's regular election related broadcasts, we have held seminars monthly from December through August, and then weekly in September, October and the beginning of November to help train and inspire volunteers, answer questions, be a resource and provide other resources to equip them not only as a volunteer but an informed pro-life citizen, and help volunteers realize they are not alone in this cause.

We regularly sent out communications on early voting and voter registration deadlines in each state, and many people receiving these emails expressed their gratitude for this information.

And the election results were not as bad as you might think. Republicans, who provide us with the pro-life candidates, won back the House of Representatives and fired Nancy Pelosi. Yet the slim margin in the House, and the fact that the Senate is still Democrat, and the President has said he will not change his approach, means that as things get worse in our country, Democrats will be the ones to blame in 2024.

We won many significant House and Senate races, and made history in New York by almost capturing the Governor's race, and flipping various House seats from blue to red. Republicans won the popular vote nationwide, with about 5 million more votes than Democrats. Parents fought back by winning school board races across the country.

Republicans now hold half of the nation's 50 governorships, roughly 60% of state legislative chambers, 63% of state house and senate seats, control of both chambers in 30 states, 6 out of 9 US Supreme Court seats, and 52.5% of state Supreme Court seats with 27 having a Republican majority. The election flipped the Supreme Court of North Carolina and swept Florida in a historic way. The Hispanic vote continued to move to the Republicans, with a historic 40%, and so did the Black vote – instead of being in the single digits, it was in the low teens. And Catholics showed a 10-point preference for Republicans.

All this and more is great for the pro-life cause. We have to keep in mind that the results of elections boil down to turnout, and many did not turn out. Moreover, those who are turning out are much harder to nail down in polling, whose dynamics have changed drastically and made it much less reliable. In 2024, turnout will no doubt be higher, and the Democrats have a much harder Senate map, needing to defend 23 seats while Republicans will need to defend only 10.

Catch up with Priests for Life at the March for Life and Walk for Life

If you'll be attending this year's March for Life in Washington, D.C., please make plans to catch up with Priests for Life.

As we have in recent years, we will host a peaceful protest and prayer rally in front of Planned Parenthood from 9 to 11 a.m. on Thursday, Jan. 19. D.C.'s flagship killing center is located at 1225 4th St. NE.

The 28th annual National Prayer Service will take place from 8:30 to 10:30 a.m. on Friday, the day of the March, at Constitution Hall, 1776 D. St. NW. The National Pro-Life Religious Council and Priests for Life annually sponsors the interdenominational event that brings together dozens of clergy and pro-life leaders to pray for an end to abortion and to present the Pro-Life Recognition Awards. This year's honorees are pioneers of the pregnancy help movement.

Women and men of the Silent No More Awareness Campaign will take part in the March and will give their testimonies of abortion regret, as they have since 2003.

The next day, Priests for Life will also help lead events at the West Coast Walk for Life, including a protest at Planned Parenthood and Silent No More testimonies.

Also, on Sunday, Jan. 22, Silent No More will again join with the Christian Defense Coalition, the Purple Sash Revolution and Faith & Liberty in the Nation's Capital for prayer and testimony in front of the U.S. Supreme Court building.

The service, inaugurated last year, is a memorial to the American holocaust, organized on the anniversary of the Roe v. Wade decision.

Priests for Life will have a booth at the March for Life expo, as well as at the Students for Life Conference at the Omni Shoreham Hotel and the Cardinal O'Connor Conference at Georgetown University.




