Silent No More in Canada celebrates 20th anniversary

The Silent No More Awareness Campaign, a joint project of Priests for Life and Anglicans for Life, is active throughout the world.

In Canada, the Campaign will celebrate its 20th anniversary on May 9th. The seeds for the project were planted decades before that, when a young woman named Angelina Steenstra lost a son in an ectopic pregnancy and realized the baby girl she gave up to abortion in 1972 was every bit as precious.

"Right away when I lost Joseph, I knew that God was going to take that experience in my life and use it for good," she said. "I knew He was drawing me into a process of healing." And she knew she was being called to break the silence surrounding

Priests for Life Participates in the Commission on the Status of Women at the UN

The Commission on the Status of Women (CSW), the largest international gathering of women, once again took place at the United Nations from March 11-22 and Priests for Life once again participated. Pro-abortion organizations and UN agencies try to use CSW to globally advance the killing of unborn children.

In its submission statement posted at PriestsForLife.org/UnitedNations, written by Marie Smith, a member of our team who heads up the Parliamentary Network for Critical Issues (PNCI), Priests for Life expressed its support for advancing the equality and the empowerment of all women and girls through actions which do not violate the right to life of girls and boys alive in the womb but not yet born.

Priests for Life also called upon CSW to commit to eliminating abortions that end the lives of unborn baby girls because they are not boys. We warned that the

preference for sons is a discrimination that not only denies a baby girl her right to life, but impedes women's and girls' empowerment and equality throughout life including through denial of food, education, and health care.

Priests for Life reminded CSW that the result of gender-biased abortion—missing women and girls—leads to increased violence and abuse as surviving women and girls are kidnapped, forced into sex trafficking and prostitution, bought and sold as brides, and forced into child marriage. Abortions for sex-selection are expected to result in over 149 million missing women globally by 2030.

We asked CSW these questions: When will girls be treated equally and recognized, respected, and protected from discrimination and violence throughout their lives? How many more girls will lose their lives through the harmful practice of sex selection abortion before the world unites to stop it?

True equality begins in the womb.



the death of her first child, Sarah Elizabeth.

In 1990, a priest in the Diocese of Toronto started a support group for women who had abortions, and when Mrs. Steenstra saw a notice in a church bulletin the following year, she contacted the priest and began to work with him to develop a program of healing.

As word of the outreach grew, Mrs. Steenstra began to receive invitations to speak at churches and other religious venues and finally, in 2003 – the same year the women from Silent No More in the U.S. first gave their testimonies as part of the March for Life – she was asked to tell her story during the March for Life in Canada.

“I got up there at Parliament Hill in Ottawa, and it was daunting. But I prayed and I was given a grace and I did it,” she recalled. After that, Jim Hughes, then the head of the Campaign Life Coalition in Canada, asked Mrs. Steenstra if she would start the Silent No More campaign there.

Before deciding, she and her husband, Walter, came to the U.S. to commemorate the life and death of Sarah Elizabeth on American soil because the abortion all those decades

before took place in Buffalo, N.Y. When they traveled to Washington, D.C., to see the campaign for themselves, co-founders Janet Morana and Georgette Forney asked Mrs. Steenstra to give her testimony in front of the steps of the Supreme Court.

“It was not about me anymore,” she said. “The Lord had taken me to that interior place for my healing ... then it became about all the women and men living in the bondage of silence.”

Four months later, on May 13, 2004, she led the first Silent No More gathering as part of the March for Life Canada. Twelve women told the stories of their abortions and the many ways they were harmed by making that choice.

“It was a profound moment for Canada,” she recalled. “People have often said to us, ‘you’re the most important part of this day.’”

Mrs. Morana has attended the Silent No More gathering in Ottawa for most of the last 20 years and will be there again this month.

“The theme this year is, ‘I will never forget you,’ and that is perfect for Silent No More,” Mrs. Morana said.

“Mothers and fathers never forget the babies they lost to abortion, and for many of them, the best way to commemorate those lives lost is to vow to be Silent No More.”

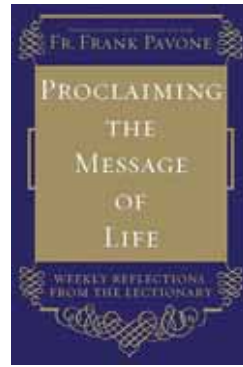
