

Silent No More Awareness Campaign End of Year Report 2020

Silent No More Awareness is a Campaign whereby Christians make the public aware of the devastation abortion brings to women, men and families. The campaign seeks to expose and heal the secrecy and silence surrounding the physical, psychological and emotional pain of abortion.

The Campaign was developed by Janet Morana, executive Director of Priests For Life and Georgette Forney, President of Anglicans for Life, with the assistance of Pastoral Director, Fr. Frank Pavone. On November 11th, 2002 they held their first formal meeting and introduced the Campaign to leaders of the Prolife Movement. In January of 2003 the very first public Gatherings were held with the women holding signs that said "I Regret My Abortion" and giving their testimony." By 2004 the first man joined the Campaign to give his testimony and held a sign saying "I Regret Lost Fatherhood."

In January of 2020 The women and men gave testimony at the March for Life in DC and the Walk for Life in San Francisco. We did participate in the March for Life Canada in May as a virtual March due to the pandemic.

The Campaign currently has 76 Regional Coordinators in the United States who assist those coming to our website to express their regret over their abortion. They assist them in finding a healing program in their area and invite them after they have gone through healing to write their testimony and be Silent No More.

As of December 2020, the Silent No More Awareness Campaign has held 2,195 Gatherings in 17 countries & all 50 states with 6,742 women and men sharing their abortion testimonies. Testimonies have also been shared at 174 high schools and universities in the last 11 years, 18 in 2019.

Due to the pandemic there were no scheduled events on Campus nor local Gatherings. However, Janet Morana and others participated in many virtual conferences and meetings via Zoom.

There are 2,972 testimonies posted on the Campaign website with 620 that are shared via video! Currently there are 19,931 people registered with the Campaign representing 77 countries.

People who are not ready to join the Campaign, are invited to 'register their regret'. So far, 6,523 women and 701 men have said they regret their abortion or lost fatherhood. 567 women and men have posted memorials to their children.

In 2011, we surveyed Campaign members; 328 surveys were returned -310 women/18 men representing 450 abortions. More than half of them did not begin looking for healing until after 20 years. The longest was 36 years and the shortest was 1 month. The majority shared their testimony and gave us permission to share it.

Many people responding to the survey made comments of how the campaign has positively impacted their lives.
