

THE FOLLOWING POLL EXCERPTS WERE TAKEN FROM A QUINNIPIAC UNIVERSITY SURVEY RELEASED IN MAY 2007. ONLY THOSE PORTIONS OF THE POLL DEALING WITH ABORTION HAVE BEEN INCLUDED HERE.

From April 25 - May 1, Quinnipiac University surveyed 1,166 American voters with a margin of error of +/- 2.9 percent, including 469 Republicans with a margin of error of +/- 4.5 percent, and 499 Democrats with a margin of error of +/- 4.4 percent.

The Quinnipiac University Poll, directed by Douglas Schwartz, Ph.D., conducts public opinion surveys in New York, New Jersey, Connecticut, Pennsylvania, Florida, Ohio and nationwide as a public service and for research.
